Begins with fresh breezes from the S.W. and pleasant weather steering S.W. employed clearing up the hold and emptying water middle part moderate breezes from the Eastward and pleasant latter part wind & weather the same steering W. by S employed repairing the main sail

This twenty four hours begins with fine weather and light winds from the S.W. steering W. by S with all sail employed repairing main sail middle part wind & weather about the same latter part fine with light air from the South ship steering W. by S with all sail employed fitting lights & blocks straps

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Remarks Thursday Nov 10th

This day begins with very fine weather and light air from the S.W. steering W. by S all sail employed fitting lights & blocks straps middle part fine with moderate breezes from S.W. ship heading W. by S with all sail latter part strong winds from S.W. ship under all sail at 8 o'clock double reefed the top sails

Remarks Friday Nov 11th

This day begins with strong breezes from the S.W. ship double reefed top sails and courses at 2 P.M. took in main sail fib & spanker at 5 P.M. close reefed top sails heading W. by S middle part still the same latter part blowing strong from the S.W. ship close reefed top sails & fore sail at 11 A.M. set fib & spanker

This twenty four hours begins with rainy weather and more moderate ship under close reefed tops at 4 P.M. wind hauled to S.W. and ship & headed to the S.W. at 10 o'clock wind to the S.W. kept the to the W. by S middle part moderate breeze ship under all sail latter part wind S.W. some rain ship with all sail steering W. by S

Remarks Sunday Nov 13th

This day begins with rainy weather wind to the S.W. ship steering W. by S at 1 o'clock tried the water in S.W. found we were in the gulf luffed the ship W. by S middle part squally wind unsteady took in light sails latter part squally at 7 o'clock double reefed the top sails wind came to West blowing strong at 10 o'clock took fore top
