

# Command towards Northampton

Remarks Monday 21<sup>st</sup> Nov 1864

This day begins with strong winds from the E by S ship with full sail at 1 P.M. took light sails for double reefed the top sails and luffed to the wind heading S by E saw several cots and a large steamer bound to the south west at 3 P.M. rounded got 30 fathoms grey sand middle part moderate breeze from E by S ship by the wind heading off shore under smaller sail at 12 o'clock wore ship and kept the ship off by W latter part at 5 o'clock luffed to the wind and stood off shore wind E by S at 12 o'clock wore ship again

Remarks Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> Nov

This day begins with thick weather and rainy wind to the N.W. ship heading E under short sail saw a sail to the windward at 4 P.M. rounded got 37 fathoms water at 7 P.M. E by S wore ship heading S middle part variable latter part strong breeze from the N.W. ship under short sail at 5 o'clock kept the ship off S by E at 11 o'clock more moderate made all sail at 12 o'clock spoke a New York pilot boat moderate hailing S by E distant 12 miles
