

Barque Peru of Santuctet Bound to the Pacific Ocean

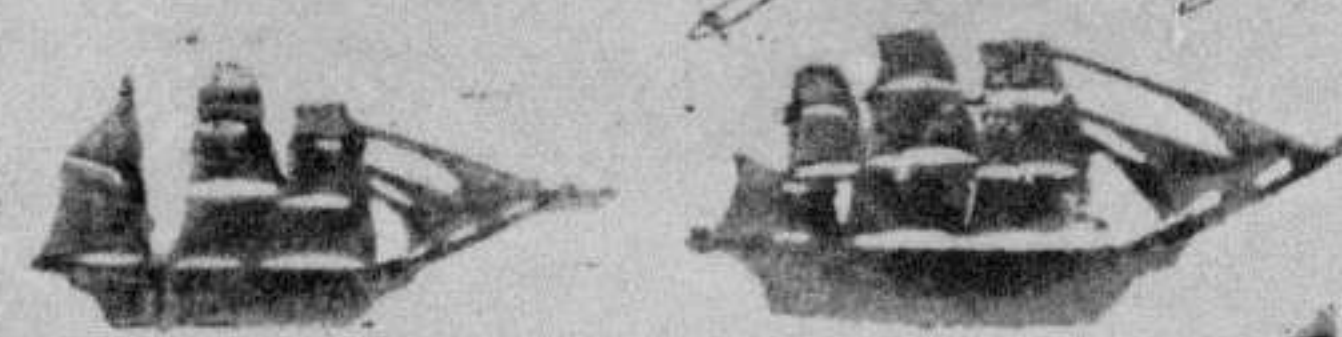
Saturday Jan 12th

Commences with light breezes from S.W. leading to the Westward at 10 AM wind from W.S.W. took to the S middle part took to the Westward latter part the same and pinbacks at 9 AM and apart of the lee had took them to be sperm whales kept off for them but nothing made of them 30 Cords Satt 42-31 S Sought by 12-04 W by sun 52-15 W

Sunday 13th

Commences with light breezes from the S.W. steering to the S.W. Satt 42-31 S Sought by 12-04 W the same latter part strong breezes from S.W. steering to the S.W. taking light sails and ship in sight steering to the S.W. at 9 AM first ashore steering to the S.W. at 11 exchanged signals with an English Barque 50 Cords

Satt 43-40 S Sought by 12-04 W by sun 53-42 W



Monday 14th

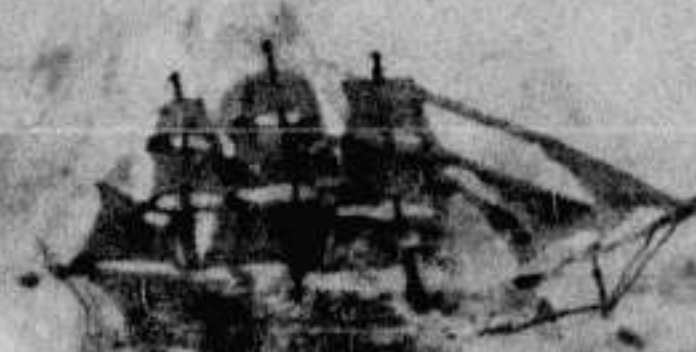
Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. at 2 PM had a thunder squall one Barque in sight steering to the S.W. middle more moderate set chain top got out sail flying jib and gaff top sail latter the steer S.W. 80 Cords by sun 55-58 W Satt 45-47 S Sought by 12-04 W

Tuesday 15th

Commences with moderate breezes from W.S.W. leading to the S.W. middle part light breezes from S.W. to S thick foggy weather leading to the Westward latter part strong breezes from the S.W. steering W.S.W. with thick foggy weather double reefed the top sails taking Main sail and spanker 80 Cords

Wednesday 16th

Commences with strong breezes from the S leading to the Westward under double reef top sails jib Main sail and spanker and pinbacks middle part took to the S.W. latter part strong breeze at daylight and sperm whales going to the windward and had taken boats could not get near them at 10 AM lost sight of the whales took up the boats and a ship to the windward at 12 AM spoke the ship Congress of Sea Portford Satt 45-13 S Sought by 12-04 W

Thursday 17

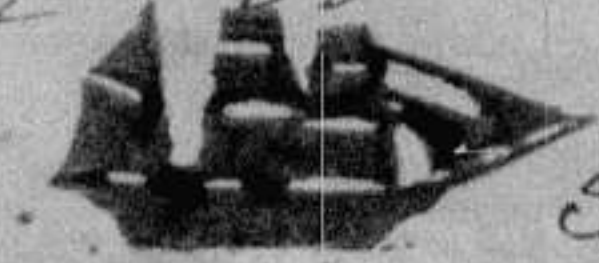
Commences with moderate breezes from S.W. leading to the S.W. in evening with Congress middle part the same latter part light breezes from the S.W. steering W.S.W. thick and rain the S in sight

Satt 46-45 S Sought by 12-04 W by sun 54-45 W

Commences with light huffling winds from various points steering W.S.W. and pinbacks and green purses middle part strong breezes and equally from the S steering S.W. taking jib and Main sail double reefed the top sails latter part moderate breeze from the Westward leading to the S employed at putting in points patches in the Main top sail Satt 46-35 S Sought by 12-04 W

Friday 18th

Commences with light breezes from the Westward leading to the S and pinbacks middle part moderate breezes and rain from the S steering S.W. latter part at 4 AM having a gale from the Westward taking fore top sail jib and spanker double reefed the Main at 10 moderate set double reef top sails jib Main sail and spanker and right to the windward to rugged to lower one Barque in sight got out mast Satt 47-60 S Sought by 12-04 W



Saturday 19th

Commences with moderate breezes and equally from the W leading to the S at 2 PM and two Right Whales heard two boats but to rugged to chase can on barrel middle part head S.W. latter part wind from W.S.W. with rain at 6 AM clear took to the Westward set whole top sails and large quantities of pinbacks at 10 took to the S Satt 47-25 S Sought by 12-04 W

Sunday 20th

Commences with strong breezes from the Westward lead S.W. and pinbacks middle part wind from S.W. took to the S.W. equally latter much the same at 10 took to the S got out Broad Satt 47-40 S Sought by 12-04 W

Monday 21th

Commences with fine breezes and fine weather from the Westward leading from S to S.W. middle part lead to the S.W. with fine weather latter part taking large quantities of pinbacks under all sail Satt 48-55 Sought by 12-04 W
