

Barque Peru of Antioquia off the Falkland Islands Jan 1850
Wednesday 23rd

Commenced with strong breezes from W & S W heading
S & S W with fine weather middle part moderate breezes
from S steering S W & S under all sail latter part wind
from the Westward heading to S & S W and fair back
Lat 54-43 S Long 63-25 W

Thursday 24th
Commenced with moderate breezes from the Westward
steering S by W under all sail on board at making Boatsails
at 4 P.M. took a heavy gale from Westward all hands and
Ship too under a chart reef main topsail main spencer
and fore topmast say sail. heading to the S at 11 more moderate
sea chart reef fore topsail latter part set fire spanker
and double reef topsail Lat 51-45 S Long 63-40 W

Friday 25th
Commenced with a strong breeze from Westering, S by W
under double reef topsails fire spanker and main sail at 3 P.M.
set whole topsail main top gallant sail and flying fire
middle part under double reef latter made all sail heading
South five miles saw the Ship Bang Cheker of Hong
Kong Lat 53-26 S Long 63-20 W

Saturday 26th
Commenced with light wind and fine weather from the W
heading to the S the B T in sight middle part light winds
from S steering S W latter part at 5 P.M. saw Station
and Cape set fire bearing S & S 30 miles Dist steer S & S by E
with strong breezes from the S at 10 P.M. the land bearing
W & N took in fore top gallant sail flying fire and main sail
the B T in sight Lat 50-30

Sunday 27th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S steering
S middle part strong from S at 4 P.M. steer S S W
latter part at 10 P.M. had a heavy squall and rain
from S S W took in main top gallant sail and double
reef the topsail at 11 P.M. clear a wind S & S steering
S & S W make sail at day light steer S & S at 10
past a Whaling Barque steering to the E heading
a Blue White and Blue original at 11 past a Brig
steering to the E Lat 55-30 S Long 65-15 W



Barque Peru of Antioquia off Cape Horn Jan 1850
Monday 28th

Commenced with strong breezes from the S steer S by W
at 3 P.M. blowing a gale taking fire main sail and fore top
and chart reef the main middle moderate set double reef
fore topsail latter part fire and spencer at 4 P.M. blowing from
the W and equally taking fire spanker and fore topsail
and chart reef the main at 5 P.M. blowing a gale taking
fore sail head S by W Lat 50-30

Tuesday 29th
Commenced with a heavy gale from the W & S W head
to the S S at 1 P.M. taking main topsail at 5 P.M. turn up
labored Boat and get aft. evening for the night middle and
latter parts the same Lat 57-40 S Long 65-30 W

Wednesday 30th
Commenced with a gale from the W & S W head S S at 2 P.M.
moderate set chart reef main topsail at 3 P.M. double reef
topsails fire and spencer and fore sail middle part moderate
breezes from the South West steering W & S W and a ship steering
to the Eastward main topsail and flying fire latter part
at day light set whole fore topsail S & S a Barque steering
to the S & S at 10 P.M. head S & S exchanged signals
with the Barque Lat 54-30 S Long 65-10 W

Thursday 31st
Commenced with strong breezes from S W at 2 P.M. went
to the W double reef the topsails at 6 P.M. blowing strong
and equally taking fire spanker chart reef the topsail
at 8 P.M. taking fore topsail middle part the same latter
part chart reef fore topsail and fore sail get out latter
Lat 58-5 S Long 68-00 W

Friday 1st
Commenced with a moderate gale from the Westward
head to the S under two chart reef topsails and
fore sail middle part the same head S & S latter part set
double reef topsails fire spanker flying fire gaff topsail
and main sail head to the S & S W with frequent squalls
Lat 54-30 S Long 66-10 W

Saturday 2nd
Commenced with strong breezes from S W and equally strong
S & S at 2 P.M. taking flying fire and gaff topsail
at 6 P.M. taking fire main sail spanker and chart reef the
topsails middle part set fire main sail spanker steering S & S
latter part light wind and rain from S & S steering S & S
make sail Lat 54-45 S Long 66-30 W
