Monday 28th

Commences with light breezes from the S steering W at 3 P.M. and Humphreys under 2 Boats could not strike and sail in sight middle part head to the C under short sail latter part steer S and employed at scraping and painting 2 Ends and Blackfish

Tuesday 29th
Commences with light breezes from the S steering S W and Blackfish under get nothing middle part the same latter part at 2 o'clock came to with the spare topsail aback to the C at daylight steer S W employed at ship duty and bark steering to the C 2 Ends

Wednesday 30th
Commences with light breeze and calm from the S steering W middle part head to the C latter part steer W S W at 8 P.M. and Heads Island Bearing W 15 Dist employed at mending a spare topsail 2 Ends

Thursday 31st
Commences with strong breezes from the S steering W S W under topsails and courses employed at mending sail at 3 P.M. and Charles Island Bearing W 10 Dist weather thick and rainy and a great number of pinbacks middle part head to the C and W under short sail latter part steer by the wind to the S W and pinbacks 2 Ends Charles Island in sight Latt S Langt

Friday 1st

Commences with light breezes from the S steering W at 2 P.M. and South Head Bearing S W 25 miles Dist middle part head to the S W latter part strong breeze and squally steer S by C and pinbacks 2 Ends

Saturday 2^d
Commences with light breezes from the S steering S W middle part off and on at Water Bay latter steer S W 25 miles Dist 2 Ends

Sunday 3^d
Commences with light breezes and calm from the C off and on at the Bay at 4 P.M. sent one boat in a fishing at 5 returned with about 50 fish middle and latter parts the same and sail South Head Bearing W by S 10 miles 2 Ends

Bark Peru of Santuckit off the Gallapagos Islands Aug 1855
Monday 4th

Commences with light breezes and calm from the S steering S at 3 P.M. exchanged signals with the Bark Domingo at 4 and Adanels Rock Bearing S 15 miles Dist at sundown puff by the wind to the W middle part strong breezes latter part calm and sail in sight 2 Ends

Tuesday 5th
Commences with fine weather and calm and Blackfish under could not get near them middle and latter part the same employed at painting the ship outside and Blackfish sail in sight 2 Ends

Wednesday 6th
Commences with fine and calm employed at painting the Rock Bearing S 10 miles Dist middle and latter the same 2 Ends

Thursday 7th
Commences calm employed at painting and sail in sight at 4 P.M. spoke Bark Domingo of New Bedford middle part light breezes from S steering C latter calm and sail in sight and the Rock Bearing S 10 miles Dist 2 Ends

Commences with light breezes from the S steering C middle and latter part the same 2 sails in sight the Rock Bearing S 15 miles Dist 2 Ends

Saturday 9th
Commences with light breeze from the S by the wind to the C spoke the Ship Robert Edwards of New Bedford and the Ship Philippe Lebonay of Fair Haven middle and latter the same sail in sight 2 Ends

Sunday 10th
Commences with light breeze from the S lead by the wind to the C spoke the Ship Robert Edwards of New Bedford middle and latter parts strong breezes and ship in sight Kingston C 8 miles 2 Ends
