Commenced with light breezes from the S head by the
wind to the P at 5 P.M. and Blackfish horder and get
3 middle the same latter part employed at cleaning and
minding the Blackfish thick clouds weather

Commenced with light breezes from the S with thick
clouds weather and Blackfish horder and get 2
middle part head to the S off latter part head to the
S employed at minding blubber

Commenced with strong breezes from the S head by the
wind to the P and Blackfish horder did not strike middle
part head to the S off and latter part head to the
S make sail employed at hauling Blackfish

Commenced with strong breezes from the S head by the
wind to the S employed at hauling part of Mercant Ship
and a Mah Ship heading to the W at 4 P.M. and latter
part heading P 8 miles Dist at 6 took to the S off and latter

Blackfish horder and get two middle and latter parts
much the same employed at minding blubber

Satt 5-14 S hant 6-14
Tuesday 7th

Commenced with light breezes from the S with thick haze
weather head by the wind to the S off and Blackfish horder
and Strike and draw middle and latter parts much the
same best a new Main Supergallant sail and making preparations
to moving the galeas aft on the barboard quarter

Satt 6-14 S hant 7-14
Wednesday 8th

Commenced with moderate breezes from the S head by the
wind to the S off employed at ripping up the old Main topsail
and castrising middle and latter the same employed at
hauling and carpentering

Satt 7-01 S hant 8-01
Thursday 9th

Commenced with strong breezes and squally from the
S head to the S off middle wind from P 8
and S taking light sails latter part the same and
finishes

Satt 8-20 S hant 9-20
Friday 10th

Commenced with strong breezes from the P S head
to the S middle part double reef the fore topsail latter
same and finishes

Satt 9-42 S hant 10-42
Saturday 11th

Commenced with strong breezes from the P S head
to the S middle and latter parts the same and finishes
employed at ship duty

Satt 11-01 S hant 12-01
Sunday 12th

Commenced with strong breezes from the P head by the
wind to the S middle and latter the same at noon took to the
S
