commenced with strong breezes from the ESE head to the ESE under double reef top sails and courses middle the same latter at 10 AM took to the ESE set whale top sails flying jib and mizzen top sail and pinbacks

Wednesday 15th

commenced with strong breezes from the ESE took to the ESE middle squally taking light sails latter part strong breezes from the E took to the E double reef the fore top sail and Breaches off the weather Broom employed at mending a fore top sail

Thursday 16th

commenced with strong trades and fine weather head to the E middle the latter part double reef the Main top sail employed at mending sail took to the ESE

Friday 17th

commenced with strong trades and fine weather under the fore top sail and bent another middle part head to the ESE latter part head to the E employed at mending the fore top sail

Saturday 18th

commenced with strong trades head by the wind to the E employed at mending sail middle part squally took to the jib and Main sail & spencer latter middle the same set jib Main sail and spencer

commenced with strong trades heading the ESE under double reef top sails and courses middle and latter part the same one sail in sight

commenced with strong breezes and squally weather head by the wind to the ESE under double reef top sails and courses middle the same latter part at daylight were ship to the E one sail in sight employed at mending sail

Monday 20th

commenced with strong and squally weather heading by the wind to the ESE under double reef top sails and courses at sundown took to the ESE middle the same latter part at daylight were ship to the E weather the same employed mending sail 50 Ends

Tuesday 21st

commenced with strong breezes and squally weather heading by the wind to the ESE under double reef top sails and courses employed at mending sail middle the same latter part moderate at daylight were ship to the ESE employed at mending sail and Blackfish and Pinbacks

commenced with a moderate breeze and fair weather heading by the wind to the ESE under double reef top sails and courses at sundown took to the ESE middle part the same latter part the same at daylight set whale top sail and Main top gallant sail employed at fitting a batt to the fore all hand to the Main top sail yard

Thursday 23rd

commenced with moderate breezes and fine weather heading by the wind to the ESE middle part strong breezes taking the Main top gallant sail heading to the ESE latter the same employed at mending sail and pinbacks

commenced with fresh breezes and fine weather steering by the wind to the ESE employed various jobs about the ship middle and latter part the same at 6 AM took to the E and pinbacks
