Monday 10th

Commenced with moderate Breezes and fine weather heading to the
P&C at sundown tack to the S middle part the same later
part at daylight tack to the P&C employed at minding Blubber
ends

Satt 13-19 S Sought 74-50

Tuesday 11th

Commenced with strong Breezes and thick sandy weather
heading to the P&C at 4 P.M. bent a new Star sail at
sundown tack to the S middle part tack to the P&C
later part the same get out Water saw Black fish 30 ends

Satt 13-15 S Sought 89-15

Wednesday 12th

Commenced with moderate Breezes with thick hazy weather
heading to the P&C employed at ship duty at sundown
taking the light sail and haul the Mainsail up middle
part the same tack to the S latter part the same
Bail Black fish 30 ends

Satt 13-31 S Sought 77-32

Thursday 13th

Commenced with strong Breezes and equally weather heading
to the S at sundown taking Mainsail and double reef the
Fore top sail middle the same latter part moderate Breezes
and equally made sail and Humpbacks and pinbacks hidden
for the Humpbacks could not get near them 30 ends

Satt 13-40 S Sought 77-30

Friday 14th

Commenced with strong Breezes from S to S.P. heading
to the P&C middle and latter the same at daylight
made sail and wore ship to the P&C 20 ends

Satt 13-15 S Sought 18-20

Saturday 15th

Commenced with light Breezes and fine weather heading to
the P&C at sundown tack to the S and taking light sail
and main sail middle part the same made sail latter part
had to the P&C and 2 sails heading to the S

Satt 12-56 S Sought 77-40

Sunday 16th

Commenced with light Breezes and fine weather heading to the
P&C 3 sails in sight and pinbacks at sundown tack to the S
and taking the light sail middle part tack to the P&C latter part
the same make sail saw Black fish lower get none

Barque Peru of Vantucket Quiseing on the Calao Ground
Monday 17th

Commenced with light Breezes and fine weather steering
P&C 3 sails in sight at 3 o'clock P.M. and the Island of
Lorezo bearing P&C 15 miles Dist at sundown tack to the S
and made all sail 5 sails in sight middle the same latter
part steer W set up the Main Sails 2 sails in sight
30 ends

Satt 12-30 S Sought 74-07

Tuesday 18th

Commenced with pleasant Breezes and fine weather steering
W employed at various jobs about the ship at sundown luff
to the wind to the S and taking the light sail middle part
the same latter part the same at daylight made sails employed
at mending the Fore topmast stay sail and Humpbacks at 10 o'clock
exchanged signals with the Ship Harper at Fair Haven
28 mths out with 350 lbs 30 ends

Satt 12-43 S Sought 77-35

Wednesday 19th

Commenced with moderate Breezes and fine weather steering
W employed at mending sail at 4 P.M. bent the Main
top sail and bent another at 5 o'clock the Ship Harper middle
part by with the Main top sail aback latter part steer W
30 ends one ship in sight

Satt 13-17 Sought 81-00

Thursday 20th

Commenced with moderate Breezes and fine weather steering
W in company with the Harper middle part by the wind to
the S latter part to the P&C employed at ship duty
30 ends

Satt 13-30 Sought 50-30

Friday 21st

Commenced with moderate Breezes and fine weather by the
wind on the P&C W tack at sundown shortened sail
middle and latter much the same steer P&C employed
at mending sail and Pinbacks 30 ends

Satt 12-43 Sought 77-32

Saturday 22nd

Commenced with moderate Breezes and fine weather steering
P&C by 10 at sundown haul up the courses and steer P&C W
middle part 2 o'clock came too with the third watch aback latter part
at daylight made sail and steer by the wind to the S

Sunday 23rd

Satt 12-55 Sought 80-17

Commenced with moderate Breezes and fine weather head by the wind to the
P&C middle part the same latter part at daylight tack to the S at 6 A.M. and
steer W later lower but could not get near them at 11 o'clock anchored the ship
in sight going to the off after for them

Satt 12-57 Sought
