Barge of Waukeget Cruising on the Calles Ground

Monday 5th
Commenced with strong breezes and fine weather head by the wind to the S E middle part the same latter part at daylight were ship to the S W and Bail so end one ship in sight
Lat 112-35 S Longt 82-40

Tuesday 6th
Commenced with strong breezes and heading to the S E at 4 PM finished Bailing and one fishhook middle the same latter part at daylight tack to the S E and one fishhook one ship in sight so ends
Lat 112-14 S Longt 82-45

Wednesday 7th
Commenced with strong breezes and pleasant weather steering by the wind to the S E middle the same latter calm employed at ship duty so ends
Lat 112-44 S Longt 82-17 W

Thursday 8th
Commenced with light breezes and calm heading to the S E middle and latter parts the same and fishhook and grass pieces one ship in sight so ends
Lat 112-45 S Longt 82-50 W

Friday 9th
Commenced with light breezes and fine weather heading to the S E at sundown were to the S W latter the same get out Meat one ship in sight and Blackfish under get nothing so ends
Lat 113-08 S Longt 81-25

Saturday 10th
Commenced with light breezes and fine weather heading to the S W and Blackfish under get nothing one ship in sight middle the same latter part much the same and Blackfish under get nothing so ends
Lat 113-50 S Longt 81-50

Sunday 11th
Commenced with light breezes and fine weather head by the wind to the S W one ship in sight middle part the same latter part calm and border and get 14 so ends
Lat 114-14 S Longt 81-57

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Monday 12th
Commenced with strong breezes and fine weather heading to the S E middle part the same latter part at daylight were ship to the S W and Bail so end one ship in sight
Lat 113-40 S Longt 82-22 W

Tuesday 13th
Commenced with light breezes from the S E steering S W and at sundown shortened sail middle part the same latter the same employed at storing oil in the Main Hatch one the barbed one ship in sight so ends
Lat 112-27 S Longt 82-53 W

Wednesday 14th
Commenced with strong breezes and fine weather steering S E at 3 PM luff by the wind to the S W at 4 PM finished Stowing middle part set gill and sparker latter at daylight were ship to the S E and Bail Blackfish so ends
Lat 112-45 S Longt 82-50 W

Thursday 15th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S E steering by the wind to the S E middle part the same latter part at daylight tack to the S W at 1 PM tack to the S E at 10 AM exchanged signals with the Joshua Barge of Old Bedford so ends
Lat 112-10 S Longt 82-02

Friday 16th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S E head by the wind to the S W at 5 PM tack to the S E one ship and Bark in sight middle part the same latter part tack to the S W so ends
Lat 112-04 S Longt 81-40 West

Saturday 17th
Commenced with moderate breezes from the S E head by the wind to the S W at 3 PM tack to the S E set up the jib-gage & two sails at night and one fishhook middle part head to the S W the same employed at rearing ship at 11 AM and Blackfish under and get four one ship in sight so ends
Lat 112-02 S Longt 81-50

Sunday 18th
Commenced with moderate breezes and fine weather Baited off Blackfishing get the barbed Boat captured middle part head to the S E latter part tack to the S W one ship in sight so ends
Lat 114-02 S Longt 81-50
