Signals a Dutch Brig the C. Wayne in sight so ends

Saturday 21th
Commences with light air from the E. Steer S. E. E
middle part calm light winds from W. W. Steer P. S. E
the C. Wayne in sight so ends

Lat 32-32 S Longt 88-24 W

Sunday 22th
Commences with light winds from the E. W. Steering P. S. E
middle and latter part same and a Barque Steering E
the C. Wayne in sight so ends

Commences with Moderate Winds from the E. W. Steering E. E. E
middle and latter part the same set up the ^{top} Mast
Winds leading from W to S. S. W employed at attending to
Main sail the C. Wayne in sight so ends

Lat 33-40 S Longt 85-50 W

Tuesday 24th
Commences with Moderate and fine weather from the Westward
steering P. S. E middle and latter part the same employed
at cleaning the iron work so ends

Commences with Moderate winds from the Westward
steering P. S. E middle part strong Breezes from the S. E.
head by the Wind to the P. S. E latter part the same
the C. Wayne accompanying Capt. E. Dain very sick Capt.
Pastan on Board of her so ends

Thursday 26th
Commences with Moderate winds from the S. E. head by
the Wind to the P. S. E middle and latter part the
same Capt. Pastan on board of the C. Wayne Capt.
Dain very sick get out Water so ends

Commences with Moderate winds from the S. Steering P. S. E
middle part the same latter part light winds from the
S. W. Steer P. S. E saw the Island of Marsafuro Bearing

Commences with light winds from the S. W. Steering P. S. E
middle part strong Breezes and squalls from the S. head
by the Wind to the P. latter part the same saw the Island
of Juan Peravendeze Bearing P. S. E 15 miles Dist so ends

Lat 33 S Longt 79-10 W

March 18th Sunday 1st
Commences with with strong Winds from the E. Steer
by the Wind to the P. under double reef middle part
middle light winds from the S. W. Steer S. E.
latter part light wind from the W. for the Island
so ends
