Barque Peru of Connecticut on the coast of Chile

Monday 2th

Commenced with light winds from the off steering for the Island at 4 P.M. the Capt went ashore at 6 returned middle part head by the wind to the S.W. latter part aware to the S. the land in sight and 50 fathoms 20 fms

Lat 34 S Longt 77 W

Tuesday 3th

Commenced with moderate winds from the S.E. head by the winds to the P. middle part the same latter part aware ship to the W.S.W. under double reef top sails and a Brig steering to the P. and the land bearing S.W. 40 Dist 20 fms

Lat 34 S Longt 77 W

Wednesday 4th

Commenced with moderate winds from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. employed at extending the fore topgallant sail middle part steer S.W. by W. under double reef top sails and courses part a ship steering to the P. latter part employed at breaking out for shacks head by the wind to the S.W. under whole top sails and courses Juan bearing S 10 W Dist 20 fms

Lat 34 S Longt 77 W

Thursday 5th

Commenced with moderate winds from the S. head by the wind to the W.S.W. under whole top sails and courses employed at breaking out for shacks at sundown double reef the top sail and took in the main sail middle part the same latter part much the same and the Island of Marapuro bearing S 30 W Dist employed at setting up shacks 20 fms

Lat 34 S Longt 77 W

Friday 6th

Commenced with moderate winds from the S.E. head to the S.W. under double reef employed at setting up shacks at sundown took in jib and spanker latter part the same at daylight made all sail. Painted the bar board Boat 20 fms

Lat 33-18 S Longt 77-55

Saturday 7th

Commenced with moderate winds from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. middle part strong breeze and squally from the S.W. later part strong breeze from the S.W. at daylight made all sail and the Island of Marapuro bearing S 30 W Dist steer S.W. to sea Island took in main sail jib and spanker 20 fms

Monday 8th

Commenced with a moderate gale from the S.W. have the ship too under short reef main top sail and fore sail at sundown Marapuro bearing S.W. by W. 10 miles Dist middle part the same heading to the S.E. latter part more moderate set double top sails jib and spanker at 10 P.M. and the Island of Juan Fernandez bearing S 30 W Dist 20 fms to the P.E. Lat 34-14 S Longt 73-48 W

Monday 9th

Commenced with strong winds from the S.W. head by the wind to the P.E. at sundown took in fore top sail jib and spanker latter part wind from S to S.W. head by the wind to the P. employed at getting ashore ready for water 20 fms the same in sight

Lat 34-11 S Longt 73-48 W

Tuesday 10th

Commenced with strong winds from the S. head by the wind to the P. under double reef middle and latter part much the same at 3 P.M. aware to the S.W. employed at setting up shacks 20 fms

Lat 34 S Longt 77 W

Wednesday 11th

Commenced with strong winds from the S. head by the wind to the S.W. at sundown took to the P. under double reef middle and latter part the same employed at setting up shacks 20 fms

Lat 34 S Longt 77 W

Thursday 12th

Commenced with strong winds from the S. head by the wind to the P. employed at setting up shacks at 3 P.M. aware to the Barque have a fresh head part 84 manth out clear middle and latter part head to the S.W. under double reef up one sail in sight 20 fms

Lat 34-20 S Longt 77-24

Friday 13th

Commenced with strong breeze from the S. at 2 P.M. aware to the S.W. sail in sight middle part moderate winds from the S.W. later part a Barque steering to the S. latter part strong winds from the S. head by the wind to the P. took in the light sails 20 fms

Lat 34-30 S Longt 76-50 W

Saturday 14th

Commenced with strong winds from the S. head by the wind to the P. at sundown double reef the top sail took in the main sail middle part the same latter part a gale took in fore top sail jib and spanker and aware ship to the S.W.

Lat 34-41 S Longt 75-10 W
