Middle part the same latter part employed at Packing  
Bread and Flour

Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup>  
Commences with pleasant weather Middle and latter  
part the same James Tugher and Charles Riley  
deserted and watch on shore

Friday 3<sup>rd</sup>  
Commences with pleasant weather Middle the same  
latter part part employed at Painting Ship and watch  
on shore Henry Whiffey deserted in Boatsticker

Saturday 4<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with pleasant weather employed getting  
ready for sea Middle part the same and watch  
on shore latter part the same

Sunday 5<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with pleasant weather Middle and latter  
part the same

Monday 6<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with pleasant weather employed at getting  
ready for sea Middle part the same latter part  
took on board a small outfit of Water

Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with pleasant weather getting ready for  
sea Middle part Carter Gamore, a Canoe started  
latter part Elipha Gabor Silvia Cook Rufino Picapica  
Jaesa Ravel William Brown Carlos Julio Meira Sabane  
latter Bertrand Seamen

Barque Ben of Connecticut Bound North  
Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup>

Commences with light winds from the S at 1 PM  
took the Anchor and steer out of the Bay Middle  
part and latter part light air and from various  
points working out of Bay

Thursday 9<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with light air from various points working  
off shore middle and latter part the same with flag  
3 sails in sight 30 Cords unloosed the cables and  
stowed the Anchors

Friday 10<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with light air and calms from various  
points steering to the S of W middle and latter part  
the same one sail in sight 30 Cords

Saturday 11<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with middle part light winds from  
the S of W at 1 PM all sail latter  
part strong breeze steer S of W one sail in  
sight 30 Cords

Sunday 12<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with strong winds from the S of W  
steering S of W middle and latter part the same  
30 Cords

Monday 13<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with strong winds from the S of W steering  
S of W at sundown took in light sails and daut the reef  
the top sails & steer W latter part breeze made  
sail and steer W 30 Cords

Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with moderate breeze from the S of W steering  
W of W employed at Painting the Anchors and other  
files latter part sea Black fish hader and get 10  
30 Cords

Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup>  
Commences with light air from the S of W head to the W  
middle and latter part the same 30 Cords
