Commenced with strong winds from the SE head by the wind to the SE at sundown taking the Main sail latter part Moderate Made all sail & steer SE

Commenced with Moderate winds from the SE steering SE at sundown taking the light sails latter part made all sail 20 Cods

Saturday 25th

Commenced with Moderate winds from the SE steering SE at sundown shortened sail & steer SE at 10 PM had the Main band 15 miles dist at 11 and Blackfish band set one 20 Cods

Sunday 26th

Commenced with light winds from the SE steering SE Middle and latter parts same 20 Blackfish under and get two 20 Cods the wind in sight

Commenced with light winds from the SE steering SE Middle & latter part the same steer SE 20 Cods

Commenced with light winds from the SE steering SE Middle & latter parts the same surge the fore & Main top sails sheets to overhaul and black them
