

July 1857
Barque Peru of Santhicket off the Galapagos Islands.

Wednesday 1st
Commenced with light breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. spoke the Schooner Monterey of Edgartown Middle the same latter part saw about four islands two sails in sight.

Thursday 2^d
Commenced with light breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. spoke the Barque, Peru of New Bedford Middle & latter part the same.

Friday 3^d
Commenced with light winds from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. employed at ship duty Middle part head to the E. latter part stuck to the S.W. and sail in sight.

Saturday 4th
Commenced with light breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. Middle part head to the E. with strong breezes making the light sails latter part the same. Reverted the jib sent in to repair at 8 A.M. double reefed the top sails.

Sunday 5th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. employed at mending the jib sail. 4 P.M. finished and sent it Middle part set whole top sail. Latter part the same and timbered.

Monday 6th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. Middle part the same latter part made moderate breeze employed at mending the spanker at 10 A.M. exchanged signals with the Barque Sapphire of New Bedford. got out meat.

Tuesday 7th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. employed at mending the spanker Middle the same latter part stuck to the S.W. Sails bent the spanker and blackfish.

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Wednesday 8th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. Middle part shortened sail latter part made sail employed at ship duty.

Thursday 9th
Commenced with moderate breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind to the S.W. spoke the Java Middle part the same latter part head to the E. same sail in sight.

Friday 10th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. steering by the wind to the S.W. spoke the Java Middle part stuck to the S.W. latter part adre ship to the E.

Saturday 11th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. Middle & latter parts the same.

Sunday 12th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. Middle part head to the E. latter part to the S.W.

Monday 13th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. Middle part head to the E. latter part to the S.W. employed at ship duty.

Tuesday 14th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. at sundown shortened sail Middle part by with the head yards aback latter part made sail and adre to the E. and blackfish employed at ship duty.

Wednesday 15th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.E. head by the wind to the S.W. at sundown shortened sail Middle part with the Span. top sail aback latter part whole sail on stand to the E. and blackfish chaser & got in.
