Commenced with strong breezes from the S & P head by the wind to the S at sundown shortened sail Middle part the same latter part wore ship to the S with thick squally weather

Friday 17th

Commenced with strong breezes and thick weather head by the wind to the S at 4 P.M. saw Blackfish under land and got one more ship to the S & P Middle part the same latter part wore ship to the S

Saturday 18th

Commenced with light breezes from the S & P head by the wind to the S Middle part the same latter part the same latter part wore ship to the S at 10 P.M. saw Blackfish & got out water

Sunday 19th

Commenced with light breezes from the S & P head by the wind to the S at sundown took in the light sail Middle part the same latter part made sail at 1 P.M. wore ship and steer S at 10 P.M. by the wind to the S at 11 P.M. exchanged signals with the ship Lancer of New Bedford and ends

Monday 20th

Commenced with light breezes from the S & P head by the wind to the S at sundown shortened sail and wore ship to the S Middle part the same latter part wore ship made sail and steer at 1 P.M. took out harbor and main top sail the Bitt and found it very rotten

Tuesday 21th

Commenced with light breezes from the S & P steering W & W employed at ship duty saw a sail heading to the S at sundown shortened sail Middle part head by the wind to the S at latter part steer S at 1 P.M.

Commenced with light breezes from the S & P steering W & W employed at ship duty Middle part head by the wind to the S at latter part the same saw tinbacks S & P ends this day got out meat

Commenced with light breezes from the S & P steering W & W at sundown shortened sail and buff by the wind to the S at latter part steer S at 1 P.M. saw Charles Island

Commenced with light breezes from the S & P steering W & W at 3 P.M. saw the South Head of Alhemarck at sundown shortened sail and buff by the wind to the S Middle part the same latter part steer W at 8 P.M. saw South Head in sight

Commenced with light breezes from the S & P steering W & W saw Bay saw Blackfish and sail in sight Middle part spoke the Bark Sea Queen of West Port latter part stood into the Bay saw nothing at 1 P.M. wore ship and stood off shore & sail in sight

Commenced with light breezes and fine weather off land at 1 P.M. saw Bay & sail in sight

Monday 27th

Commenced with light breezes and fine weather off land at 1 P.M. spoke the Bark the Chilli of New Bedford and tinbacks

Commenced with light breezes and fine weather off land at 1 P.M. Middle the same latter part spoke the Bark Maarsing light of old Buff
