Barque Peru of Chantucket Bound to Chumbeze
Thursday 8th

Commenced with strong Breeze and Squall from the
S head by the wind to the S E Middle and latter part
light Breeze and foggy make all sail and copper
the oil

Sat 10th 45 S Longt 83-00
Friday 9th
Commenced with light Breeze from the S head by
the wind to the S E Middle part the same latter
part employed at standing down oil in the main hatch

Sat 11th
Commenced with light Breeze and fine weather
head by the wind to the S E finished standing
Middle part head to the Headsteward from the
Main to 3 latter part head to the S E

Sun 11th
Commenced with Moderate Breeze from the
S E and thick clouds weather head by the wind
to the S E Middle part the same latter
part fine weather steering S E

Sat 12th 20 S Longt 84-54
Monday 12th
Commenced with Moderate Breeze from the S
steering S E Middle part the same latter
part Sat 8 AM part to the Island of St. Clara
at noon let go the Anchor in 7 fathoms of water
at Chumbeze

Tuesday 13th
Commenced with fine weather employed at getting
cash ready for water latter part took
on shore 28 casks

Wednesday 14th
Commenced with fine weather employed at
getting off water latter part employed
at standing water and washing ship

Barque Peru of Chantucket at Anchor at Chumbeze
Thursday 15th

Commenced with fine weather employed at standing
water & painting ship

Friday 16th
Commenced with fine weather employed at painting
latter part sent a Raft ashore for water

Saturday 17th
Commenced with fine weather employed at taking
aboard Wood Water &

Sunday 18th
Commenced with fine weather sent the barboard
watch ashore for 24 hours liberty

Monday 19th
Commenced with fine weather employed at painting
the watch ashore

Tuesday 20th
Commenced with fine weather employed at taking
aboard Recruits and watch ashore

Wednesday 21th
Commenced with fine weather took aboard a Raft
of water

Thursday 22th
Commenced with fine weather all hands aboard
but one Man Eugene Deserted employed at
taking Wood &

Friday 23th
Commenced with fine weather took ashore a small
raft for water

Saturday 24th
Commenced with fine weather employed at getting
ready for sea
