Bark Peru of Chintucket Cruising around the galapagos
Saturday 23rd

Commenced with light breezes from the S
with thick hazy weather leading by the wind
to the E Middle and latter part light breeze
from the NNE and rain leading to
SSE and sail in sight

Sunday 24th
Commenced with light breezes from the NNE
leading to the SSE Middle and latter part
same Whirlwind in sight

Monday 25th
Commenced with light breezes from the SSW
by the wind to the ESE Middle part steer ESE
latter part lead by the wind to the ESE and
Whirlwind bearing S 8 miles East

Tuesday 26th
Commenced with light breezes from the S
by the wind to the E Middle and latter part
the same and a Bark standing to the N

Wednesday 27th
Commenced with light breezes from the S
leading by the wind to the E employed at setting
up the main rigging Middle part heavy rain
and wind from various points latter part light
breezes from the ESE and ship to the ESE

Thursday 28th
Commenced with light breezes from the S
to the E Middle part the same latter part
strong breezes from the ESE took to the SSW
just a Bark standing to the E employed at setting
the main rigging

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Friday 29th

Commenced with moderate breezes from the S
lead by the wind to the SSW employed at setting
up rigging at sundown took to the E part of
ship to the NNE and sailing Middle and latter
part the same

Saturday 30th
Commenced with moderate breezes from the S
lead by the wind to the ESE Middle part the same latter
part employed at setting up the fore stay &
mending the main topgallant sail

Sunday 31st
Commenced with moderate breezes from the S
leading to the E Middle part the same latter part at
daylight saw whales at 6 AM hauled for the
first time one whale at noon took him to
the ship

Monday Feb 1st 1858
Commenced with breezes from the S at 1 PM were
ship to the W and commenced cutting at 4 finished
and were to the E Middle part strong breezes
from the E were to the S the most of the day
main equally latter part strong breezes from
the S leading SSW took in the light sails
at 10 AM commenced Boiling

Tuesday 2nd
Commenced with light breezes from the S
by the wind to the SSW employed at Boiling
Middle part the same latter part the same
at daylight took to the ESE at noon to the
