border at 4 strike one at 5 took him to the
ship Middle part by the whale & get ready
for cutting latter part at daylight were ship to
the W and took in the head at 8 A.M. were to the
E and cut the body at 10 finished

Monday 15th

Commenced with Moderate Breezes from the S
head by the wind to the E commenced Bailing Middle
the same latter part light Breezes at 7 A.M. saw
Whales border and chase

Tuesday 16th

Commenced with light Breezes from S.W. chasing
Whales at 4 P.M. strike two at 6 P.M. took one
Whale to the ship at 7 took the other Middle part
by the Whales latter part were ship to the S.W.
and commenced cutting at noon finished cutting one
Whale saw Breaches

Wednesday 17th

Commenced with strong Breezes from the S.W.
& squally at 3 P.M. finished cutting & were to
the E at 5 P.M. heavy rain at 6 were to the W
Middle part the same with rain latter part
light Bailing winds & heavy rain at 11 A.M. unbent
the fore topsail & got it over the by work &
Commenced Bailing

Commenced with light Bailing winds leading from
E to S.W. & riving Bailing Middle the same latter part
strong Breezes from the S.W. and squally Bailing

Commenced with Moderate Breezes from the S.W. heading
to the E Bailing at 6 P.M. finished Bailing Middle part

Commenced with light Breezes from the S heading to the
E at sundown were ship to the W Middle &
latter parts the same Cooper the oil and Black fish

Lat 12-09 S Long 88-50 W

Sunday 21st

Commenced with light Breezes from the S heading to
the S.W. Coopering oil Middle part light Breezes from
the Eastward were ship to the S latter part the same
with light rain squalls and one forecast

Lat 12-30 S Long 88-34 W

Monday 22nd

Commenced with light Breezes from the E.S.E. heading
to the S.W. at sundown took in the light sails
latter part the same latter part Moderate Breezes
& rain squalls commenced breaking out in the Main
Mast for water at 6 P.M. saw Whales at 8 border
at 9 strike one Whale at 10 took him to the ship
and chase at noon took up the boats the Whales
one to windward

Tuesday 23rd

Commenced with Moderate Breezes from the E.S.E.
and rainey going by the Whale & putting down oil in
the fore & Main Mast to make room at 4 commenced
cutting at 6 P.M. finished Middle rainey were ship
to the S.W. latter part commenced Bailing at noon were
ship to the E.S.E.
