Friday 14th Lat 11-20 Long 89-04
Commenced with Moderate Breezes from the S.E. heading to the E. Middle and latter parts the same

Saturday 15th Lat 11-25 S Long 88-58
Commenced with Moderate Breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the E. Middle part the same latter part head to the S.S.W. with thick cloudy weather get out Breeze

Sunday 16th Lat 12-05 S Long 88-37 W
Commenced with Moderate Breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the S.S.W. and Blackfish under get one Middle part head to the E. latter part head to the S.S.W. with strong Breezes and squally taking the main top gallant sail

Monday 17th Lat 11-54 S Long 88
Commenced with Strong Breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind the E. Middle part head to the S.S.W. latter part the same the Ship heaving 1200 strokes in 24 hours

Tuesday 18th Lat 12-26 S Long 90-55
Commenced with Strong Breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the S.S.W. Middle & latter part head to the E. employed at Ship duty

Wednesday 19th Lat 12-21 S Long 89-47 W
Commenced with Strong Breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the S.S.W. Middle & latter part head to the E. employed at Ship duty

Thursday 22nd Lat 11-53 S Long 88-14
Commenced with Strong Breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the E. get out about 2 M.B. for Bark Middle & latter part much the same

Friday 23rd Lat 12-05 S Long 88-14
Commenced with Strong Breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the E. Middle part took to the S.S.W. latter part the same unbent the fore sail to repair it

Saturday 24th Lat 12-25 S Long 88-45
Commenced with Strong Breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the S.S.W. at 4 P.M. bent the fore sail Middle part head to the E. latter to the S.S.W.

Sunday 25th Lat 12-16 S Long 88-41
Commenced with Moderate Breezes from the S.E. heading by the wind to the S.S.W. Middle part head to the E. latter part steer by S. and Blackfish under get nothing

Monday 26th Lat 11-26 S Long 89-34 W
Commenced with Strong Breezes from the S.E. steering by Middle part steer by S. and Blackfish under get nothing

Tuesday 27th Lat 12-26 S Long 90-55
Commenced with Moderate Breezes from the S.E. and Clatham Island steer by the wind to the S.S.W. at 5 P.M. and Clatham Island Middle part steer by S. latter part the same and Charles Island and 2 sail

Wednesday 28th Lat 12-21 S Long 89-47 W
Commenced with Moderate Breezes from the S.E. steering by W. at 1 P.M. spoke the Bark Merlin Bailing Middle part off and on between Charles and Almaral latter part steer by W.
