Commenced with light breezes from the S.P.
heading by the wind to the P Middle &
latter part the same Whington Bearing
P 15 miles Dist

Bark Peru of Clamfuckeret Bounding to the Captains
Tuesday 10th
Commenced with light breezes from the S.P. heading
by the wind to the P Middle part the same
latter part strong breezes heading P by S
took in the S. J gallant sail

Wednesday 11th
Commenced with strong breezes from the
P heading by the wind to the P Middle part
more moderate set the fore J gallant sail
latter strong breezes and equally took in
fore & main J gallant sail

Thursday 12th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.P.
heading by the wind to the P by S Middle &
latter part the same

Friday 13th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.P.
heading P by S under all sail Middle &
latter part the same

Saturday 14th
Commenced with strong breezes from the S.P.
heading P by S Middle & latter part the
same get out water

Sunday 15th
Commenced with moderate breezes from the S.P.
head by the wind to the P Middle & latter
part the same

Monday 16th
Commenced with strong breezes under thick
foggy weather from the S.P. Middle part
the same latter part rainy employed at getting
