Commenced with strong breeze from the S at sundown tack to the W & W Middle part the same latter part employed at setting up Shaaks at 9 AM and Wale at 11 London at 11 1/2 struck one at 12 took him to the ship two Boats off chasing

Wednesday 18th
Commenced with Moderate Breeze from S at sundown Wale at 3 PM took up the Boats the Wale gone out of sight commenced cutting at 5 finished and ware ship to the S & Middle part the same latter part ware ship to the Westward and commenced Bailing

Thursday 19th
Commenced with strong Breeze from the S & W leading by the wind to the W employed at Bailing at sundown tack to the S & Middle part finished Bailing Boats latter part Bailing down

Lat 40 = 53 S Long 83 = 34 W
Friday 20th
Commenced with strong Breeze from the S & W leading to the S at dawn finished Bailing Middle part the same latter part employed at setting up Shaaks

Lat 40 = 16 S Long 84 = 10 W
Saturday 21th
Commenced with strong Breeze from the S & W employed at setting up Shaaks at 11 there 24 steering S W by W

Lat 40 = 31 S Long 85 = 28
Sunday 22th
Commenced with strong Breeze from the S & W steering S W by W Middle & latter part the same get out Mast

Lat 40 = 44 S Long 85 = 50

Bark Peru of Connecticut Between the Islands & Estuaries
Monday 23th

Commenced with strong Breeze from the S & W steering S W Middle part the same latter part put out Water covering sail & standing under 3 1/2 off the O 20 Days but filled up the Main Hatch Way

Lat 40 = 12 S Long 88 = 42 W
Tuesday 24th
Commenced with strong Breeze from the S & W steering S W Middle & latter part the same employed at standing out Water in the Fore Hale

Lat 40 = 51 S Long 90 = 13 W
Wednesday 25th
Commenced with strong Breeze from the S & W steering S W employed at standing out Water in the Fore Hale at sundown Ware ship to the S & Middle part the same latter part light sail employed at standing Water get out Mast

Lat 40 = 15 S Long 90 = 16
Thursday 26th
Commenced with light Breeze from the S & W leading by the wind to the S & Middle part the same latter part Ware ship to the S & W and made all sail

Lat 40 = 40 S Long 90 = 20 W
Friday 27th
Commenced with light Breeze from the S & W leading by the wind to the S & Middle part the same latter part tack and steer S & W

Lat 40 = 41 S Long 90 = 40 W
Saturday 28th
Commenced with light Breeze from the S & W steering S & W at sundown luff to the wind to the S & Middle part the same latter part steer S & W by E

Lat 40 = 24 S Long 90 = 19 W

Commenced with light Breeze from the S & W steering S & W at sundown luff to the wind to the S & Middle part the same latter part steer S & W and Wale Island off
