All these 24 hours light breeze and  
rainy latter part sent two boats off  
after thumpacks employed at standing water

Monday 27<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with light breeze and fine weather  
employed at getting water and recruited

Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> Wednesday  
Commenced with strong breeze getting off  
water latter part employed at standing water  
and cleaning the copper on the sea board with

Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with light breeze employed at standing  
water latter part getting ready for sea  
get out about

Thursday 30<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong breeze from the SSW at  
2 P.M. got under way and stood to anchor  
& chains Middle part head to the W of W  
latter part the same with rain at 6 A.M.  
saw a sperm whale going to the eastward  
called a sperm whale going to the eastward  
at 7 were ship and stood to the eastward  
at 11 were to the westward saw nothing  
the hand in sight so ends this day &  
year

Bark Peru of Glantucket bound to the red sea

Commenced with light breeze from the SSW  
head by the wind to the W of W Middle  
part light breeze from the W tack to  
the SSW latter part rainy tack to the  
W of W

Sat 2<sup>nd</sup> at day  
Commenced with strong breeze from the SSW  
steering by the wind to the W of W Middle  
& latter part the same

Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup>  
Commenced with strong breeze from the SSW  
by the wind to the W Middle part the same  
latter part at 8 A.M. saw sperm whales  
at 9 heard and strike 3 drawn from this and  
last from the 3<sup>rd</sup> by the line getting haul of  
two whales

Monday 4<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong breeze from the SSW  
at 1 P.M. took up the boats and head to the SE  
at 4 saw whale breaching ahead at sundown  
took in light sail & haul up the mainsail  
Middle part the same latter part made  
sail and tack to the W saw thumpacks

Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with moderate breeze from the SSW  
steering by the wind to the W Middle & latter  
parts the same

Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with light breeze from the SSW  
steering W by S at sundown tack to the SE  
Middle part the same latter part tack to the  
W of W

Thursday 7<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong breeze from the SSW heading  
to the W Middle & latter parts the same

Friday 8<sup>th</sup>  
Commenced with strong breeze from the SSW heading  
to the W Middle & latter parts the same
