at 4 PM Middle part took in light sails latter
part raring heading W & W

Commenced with strong breeze and set sail
heading S & W Middle the same latter set light
sails and Chatham Island Bearing W 20 miles Dist

Friday 17th

Commenced with light breeze heading S & W at
6 PM took in head & Middle the same latter
took and head S & W and Chatham & Waids
Island

Saturday 18th

Commenced with light breeze at 4 PM took in
head & Middle part took in head S & W at daylight
and a bark at 11 AM and his call for
Whales but saw Whales or Boats Waids
Chatham & Charles in sight

Sunday 19th

Commenced with light breeze heading S & W got
out water Middle part took twice latter
part at 8 AM saw Whales under & strike 1
at 10 took the Whales to the ship took
Boats off chasing Charles Bearing W By W
20 miles Dist

Commenced with strong breeze from the S at
1 PM took up the Boats and commenced cutting
at 4 finished and made all sail heading
S By W Middle part took to the S & W latter
part at daylight commenced Bailing at 6 AM
took to the S and back in light Charles
Bearing W By S 20 miles Dist

Middle the same latter part finished at 10 AM
and Whales under three Boats and Chase

Commenced with strong breeze chasing Whales
at 5 PM came on board Whales came out of sight
Middle part light breeze head S By S latter part
strong breeze at daylight took and set
W Waids Island Bearing W By S 15 miles Dist

Commenced with strong breeze from the S head
By the wind to the S & a finback at dawn
took to the S Charles Bearing W By S 15 miles Dist
Middle light breeze latter part the same
employed at Chapering & standing down in the
After Hole Waids Bearing W By S 20 miles Dist

Commenced with light breeze head to the S Middle
the same latter part set W employed at
washing Ship Charles Island Bearing W
20 miles Dist
