Saturday 22nd
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the E Middle part tack to the
S W employes at putting riggin get out sheet
Lat 10° 30' Long 88° 03'

Sunday 23rd
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the S W Middle part the same
Batter part at daylight saw Whales harder
and chase at noon came aboard the Whales
gone out of sight to the N wind gear head to
the E Lat 10° 32' Long 88° 03'

Monday 24th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the E Middle part head S E
Batter part tack to the S W these 24 hours
the Ship has been making more water than
usual break out in fore hole & found the leak
in one of the old pipes
Lat 10° 37' S Long 88° 55'

Tuesday 25th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the S W at 12m due to
the E W Middle part the same batter part
tack to the S W

Lat 10° 41' S Long 89° 09'
Wednesday 26th
Commenced with light breeze from the S
head by the wind to the S W Middle & batter
parts the same

Lat 10° 48' S Long 90° 47'
Thursday 27th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the S W and Black fish harder
to get 3 Middle batter parts head to the
E

Lat 10° 52' 05" Long 91° 44"
Friday 28th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the E Middle & batter part
the same sail Black fish one sail in sight
Lat S Long

Commenced with light breeze from the S head By
the wind to the E at 4 PM spoke Bark Mary France
Middle part head to the S W

Sunday 30th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head By the
wind to the E at 4 PM due to the S W Head
bearing Cr 15 mile Dist Middle part the same
batter part at 7 AM tack to the E at when tack
to the S W Head in sight and 1 bark

Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the E Middle part head to the S W
Batter part head to the E Two bark in sight
Lat 10° 58' S Long

Tuesday February 1st 1859
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the E Middle part head to
the S Batter part head to the E 3 sail in
sight Heads Island in sight Lat S Long

Commenced with light breeze from the S E
head by the wind to the E Middle part head
to the S W Batter part head to the E 3 sail in
sight

Thursday 3rd
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
head by the wind to the E Middle part head to
the S W Batter part the same 4 sail in sight
Lat 10° 52' 09" S Long

Friday 4th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the E Middle part by which batter
part & two or by N 3 sail in sight
