Bark Peru of San Francisco off the Galapagos Islands
Saturday 22nd

Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the E Middle part tack to the
S W employed at fitting rigging get out meat
Lat 01=30 Long 88-03

Sunday 23rd
Commenced with light breeze from the S heading
By the wind to the S W Middle part the same
rather part at daylight saw Whales border
and chase at dawn came on board the Whales
gone out of sight to the W Middle part head to the
S Lat 01=32 Long 88-42

Monday 24th
Commenced with light breeze from the S heading
By the wind to the E Middle part head to the S
rather part tack to the S W these 24 hours
the ship has been making more water than
usual broke out in bare hole & found the heat
in one of the old pipes
Lat 01=37 Long 88-55

Tuesday 25th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the S W at sundown wore to
the E Middle part the same rather part
tack to the S W
Lat 01=41 Long 89-09

Wednesday 26th
Commenced with light breeze from the S
head by the wind to the S W Middle & rather
parts the same
Lat 02=48 Long 90-47

Thursday 27th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the S W saw Black fish border
to get 3 Middle & rather parts head to the
S
Lat 02=55 Long 91-49

Friday 28th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
By the wind to the E Middle & rather part
the same sail Black fish one sail in sight
Lat 02=59 Long 92-49

Bark Peru of San Francisco off the Galapagos Islands
Saturday 29th

Commenced with light breeze from the S head by
the wind to the E at 4 PM spoke Bark Mary Frances
Middle part head to the S W
Lat 02=59 Long 92-49

Sunday 30th
Commenced with light breeze from S head by the
wind to the E at 4 PM wore to the S W Head
bearing 15 mile Dist Middle part the same
rather part at 7 AM tack to the E at dawn tack
to the S W Head in sight and 1 Bark
Lat 02=58 Long 92-49

Monday 31st
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
by the wind to the E Middle part head to the S W
rather part head to the E two Barks in sight
Lat 02=58 Long 92-49

Tuesday February 1st 1859
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
by the wind to the E Middle part head to
the S rather part head to the E 3 sails in
sight Head Island in sight
Lat 02=58 Long 92-49

Wednesday 2nd
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
by the wind to the E Middle part head
to the S W rather part head to the E 3 sails
in sight
Lat 02=58 Long 92-49

Thursday 3rd
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
by the wind to the E Middle part head to
the S W rather part the same 4 sails in sight
Lat 02=59 Long 92-49

Friday 4th
Commenced with light breeze from the S head
by the wind to the E Middle part by a black rather
part steer & by W 3 sails in sight
Lat 02=59 Long 92-49
