Bark Peru of Wamtucho Bound to Talcahuano
Friday 17th

Commenced with Moderate breezes from the E heading
by the wind S by E Middle part strong breezes
head S by E better part Moderate. Broke out
in the fore hatch and found the keels one on
the starboard & one on the larboard side. The
one on the larboard side could not get at
other

Lat 11-01 S Long 100-00 W

Saturday 19th

Commenced with Moderate breezes from the E heading
S by E under all sail Middle part strong breezes
taking light sails better part Moderate
under all sail ship leaking & used Pumps
carefully attended to

Lat 13-00 S Long 110-45 W

Sunday 20th

Commenced with Moderate breezes from the E heading
S by E at 4 PM strong breezes taking light
sails & double reefed the topsails Middle
part Moderate Made all sail latter part
the same

Lat 14-54 S Long 111-30 W

Monday 21st

Commenced with fresh breezes from the E heading
S by E Middle & latter parts the same employed
at breaking out in the fore hatch for water

Lat 16-34 S Long 112-08 W

Tuesday 22nd

Commenced with fresh breezes from the E heading
S by E at 4 PM taking fore topgallant sail
Middle part strong breezes taking main topgal-
lant sail & double reefed the topsails latter part
heavy squalls from the E by E head S by E
took the boats up on the upper cranes the ship
leaking about same Pumps carefully attended
to

Lat 18-20 S Long 112-27 W

March 1859
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Wednesday 23rd

Commenced with strong breezes from the E by E heading
S by E under double reef Middle part Moderate
Made all sail latter part the same head S by E

Lat 20-10 S Long 112-23 W

Thursday 24th

Commenced with strong breezes from the E heading
S by E under all sail Middle part Moderate latter
part at daylight saw sperm whale going to
the starboard at 7 PM. Sander and chase at dawn came
onboard the whales gone out of sight were ship to
the S by E

Lat 21-30 S Long 112-40 W

Friday 25th

Commenced with Moderate breezes from the E heading
S by E Middle & latter part the same employed at
taking the quarter deck

Lat 23-00 S Long 112-43 W

Saturday 26th

Commenced with Moderate breezes from the E heading
S by E Middle & latter parts the same Bent a red
main topgallant sail & main royal the ship in
light winds makes but little water Pumps
carefully attended to

Lat 24-20 S Long 112-45 W

Sunday 27th

Commenced with Moderate breezes from the E by E
steering S by E Middle part light breezes from the
W latter part Moderate breezes from the W by W
steering S by E

Lat 25-25 S Long = = W

Monday 28th

Commenced with Moderate breezes from the W by W
steering S by E Middle part squally latter
part strong breeze steered at 11 PM. saw
Easter Island bearing E by N 25 miles distant employed
at mending sail

Lat 26-55 S Long 109-53 W
