by the wind to the S.W. sails in sight at sundown
the land bearing E 3/4 N. 1/2 E. Middle part strong breeze
from the S.E. & S.W. by S. took in the light sails
latter part moderate made all sail at 4 P.M. strong
then made his appearance which had started himself
and he agreed to be his mate on board the same as if he were a ship
in every respect and belonged to the ship by his name
his name William ~~Went~~ ^{Went} Campbell

Friday 6th

Commenced with light breeze from the W. & S.W. heading
employed at various jobs about the ship got out the
& Middle Middle part strong breeze from the W. & S.W. took
in the light sails & double reefed the fore topsail latter
part blowing a gale took in fore sail fore topsail &
last reef the main topsail & tacking S.W. at 4 P.M.
blowing heavy & the ship making bad
weather as it blew too to the W. at 8 P.M. took in
the main topsail & set the main spencer the ship
making no water to speak of

Saturday 7th

Commenced with a heavy gale from the W. have too under
main spencer & fore topsail at 4 P.M. set
last reef main topsail & reef fore sail at 11 P.M. heavy squalls
took in main topsail & fore sail Middle part the same
latter part moderate at 7 P.M. made all sail wind S.E.
heading to the S.W.

Commenced with light breeze from the S.E. heading by
the wind to the S.W. Middle & latter part calm

Commenced with light breeze from the W. heading S.W.
Middle part strong breeze & squalls from the W. & S.W.
tacking S.W. took in light sails & double reefed the
fore sail latter part set the main topsail at 11 P.M. reefed the
main topsail & set the main sail Lat 38-33 S Long 76-51 W

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Friday 10th

Commenced with a gale from the S.W. have too under a
last reef main topsail & main spencer Middle part set
a reef fore sail latter part more moderate set last
reef fore topsail at 7 P.M. took in main sail spencer & whale
main topsail heading S.E.

Saturday 11th

Commenced with moderate breeze from the W. & S.W. heading
by the wind to the S.E. Middle part strong breeze & squalls
from the W. & S.W. tacking S.W. took in the light sails
& double reefed the fore topsail latter at 11 P.M. took in
the main sail & double reefed the main topsail
