Bark Tern of Wampanoag Bound off East Coast of Patagonia
Tuesday 7th

Commenced with strong breeze from the W & steering by the wind under all sail Middle part wind from NW & W latter part the same employed at altering topgallant & studying sails

Wednesday 8th

Commenced with Moderate breeze from the NW steering by the wind to the E Middle part calm latter part light winds from the S & W steering by the wind

Lat 41-40 Long 42-58
Thursday 9th

Commenced with strong breeze from the S & steering by the wind Middle part the same latter part calm employed at ship duty

Lat 40-13 Long 40-30
Friday 10th

Commenced with light breeze from the NW steering by the wind to the E at 4 P.M. steering breeze took in the light sail Middle part took in jib main sail & spanker & closed reef the topsails latter part took in jib main sail & spanker & closed reef topsails wind NW steering by the wind at 10 A.M. took in jib main sail & spanker the ship making 700 strokes in 24 hours

Saturday 11th

Commenced with strong breeze from the W & steering by the wind under close reef topsails & bare sail Middle part the same latter part Moderate winds from the S & W made all sail & steering by the wind

Sunday 12th

Commenced with Moderate breeze from the S & steering by the wind to the E Middle part calm latter part strong breeze from the W took in light sails

Commenced with strong breeze from the W & steering by the wind under topsails & courses Middle part the same latter part Moderate breeze all sail employed at various jobs about ship

Tuesday 14th

Commenced with Moderate breeze from the W & steering by the wind to the E Middle & latter parts the same employed at fitting rigging

Lat 31-57 Long 32-45
Wednesday 15th

Commenced with light breeze from the W & steering by the wind to the E Middle part calm latter part light breeze from the NW steering by the wind to the E employed at fitting rigging

Lat 31-40 Long 32-02
Thursday 16th

Commenced with Moderate breeze from the NW steering by the wind to the E Middle part the same latter part fresh breeze from the NW steering by the wind to the E saw a number of vessels steering to the E & S

Lat 31-15 Long 31-10
Friday 17th

Commenced with fresh breeze from the NW steering by the wind to the E Middle & latter part the same employed at fitting rigging saw a number of vessels steering to the E & S

Saturday 18th

Commenced with fresh breeze from the NW steering by the wind to the E Middle part the same latter part head wind employed at fitting rigging

Commenced with fresh breeze from the NW steering by the wind to the E Middle part the same latter part wind W steering by the wind Lat 27-04
