& Mast reef the Main Top sail Middle part wind W heading
W by N at Mast reef Fore Top sail batter part wind W by N
batter part & head W by N with clear weather made all
sail at 10 A.M. calm

Monday 25th

Commenced with light breeze from the E.S.E. steering
W by N Middle part strong breeze from the
S.E. took in the light sails & double reef the Top sail
with thick rainy weather batter part much the
made all sail at 9 A.M. clear weather exchanged
signals with an American Bark steering to
the S.E. employed at painting boats & blacking
one of the cables
