reefed top sails, unbent & stored away

7th Most wind SW on I & S all sail set
washed up decks, Middle port a smart gale,
latter most, Long at 8 AM 151 1/2 ^{new} 152 ^{old} W

Sunday 8th Lat 59, 39 Long 152.00

8th Most wind from SW to W Main top sail
set on I & S, at sunset took in double reefs
headed to the N, Middle port strong gales &
squally at night kept of E, & S & set double
reefed top sails Lat 58 05

Monday 9th Long 153, 23

9th Strong gales from the N & S on I & S
saw a ship, lying to subject to take 2
right whales to require to whale took in
sail at 11 more to the E at daylight kept of S by E
stowing away Bone to 3 ships in company

Tuesday 10th Lat 52 05 Long 153 25

10th Strong gales at NW on I by E double reefed
top sails, jil & Main sail stored away, Bone unsown
cutting falls to Middle port strong & squally, wind
SW at 7 more to the W headed jil & Main sail
latter port most at 11 1202 ~~W~~ I wind W

through the Straits of Passamaquoddy ships
in sight Thursday 12th

12th Strong gales at NW on I & S & E Main
top sail set Middle port the same latter do
a heavy gale, twisted boats to the land heads

13th Hard gales at W on I & Main top sail set
Middle port very strong double reefed
Main top sail latter port most wind SW
on I & S all sail set Lat 49 08 Long 165 13

Saturday 14th

14th Fresh gales at SW on I & S all sail set, Drying
Middle port squally & heavy wind W latter port a
breeze, studding double reefed Main top sail
toe Main top sail all to pieces Lat 48 15

Sunday 15th Long 170 53

15th Blowing heavy from the W heading before the
sea at 2 a late wind SW on I & S by E set Main
top sail, Middle port fine latter do Bent Main top sail
wind light from the S all sail set

Tuesday 16th

16th Fine wind SW on I by S Bent & set Main
top sail, Depoising Main top sail to Middle port
heavy & squally wind S & at 6 wind E backed
to the S latter port strong gales at NW on I close
reefed Main top sail heading & carried
away head sails to a heavy head beating
sea Olat p
