

Ship put out sailing towards the Islands

Thursday 18th Oct 1855

18th Fine wind light from the S heading E all sail set at 5 wind S S W set studding sails Middle part wind S E latter part do Strong gales double reefed

Friday 19th

19th Hard gales from the S E double reefed top sail hauled jib & main sail at 8 hauled fore top sail at 9 wind W con E double reefed at daylight set main top sail latter part strong gales at W S W con E by S set to 5 std sail

Lat 41 1/2 Long 179 40 East

Saturday 20th

20th Strong gales at W S W con E by S main top & royal, split std, & spinnings the boom Middle part strong gales at W. Latter do close hauled top a high quick sea

Lat 40 00

Sunday 21st Long 175 05 West

21st A Heavy gale at W S W con E S E close hauled a heavy, surging sea, Middle part a part latter most all sail set con S E E

Lat 43 52

Monday 22nd Long 171 50 W

22nd Most wind at W S con S E by E all sail set std sails & royal, M. Middle part fine latter do wind S heading E

Tuesday 23rd

23rd Strong increasing gales from the S E heading to the E double reefed the top sails hauled jib & main sail Middle part strong gales, hauled fore top sail at daylight wind S S W set double reefed top sails jib & main sail thick & rainy

Lat 46 30

Sailing towards the Sandwich Islands

Wednesday 24th Oct 1855

24th Strong gales from the S W con S E by E set by sail over single reefs latter Middle part the same latter part all sails set squally with light showers of rain

Lat 38 00 Long 163 30

Thursday 25th

25th Most wind S S W heading S E by E all sail set sent up main top mast & yards Bent & set the sail, Middle part fine, latter do squally wind at N, washing Bone

Lat 38 05

Friday 26th

26th Most, Rainy light winds from S to S W set up fore top mast & yards Bent & set the sail, Middle part fine, latter do squally wind at N, washing Bone heavy swell from the S

Saturday 27th

27th Most wind N con S E & S all sail set washing Bone, Rainy & squally, heavy swell from the N to N W main topmast Middle part sail & squally latter do washing ship

Lat about 32 00

Sunday 28th Long 160 50

28th Most wind S S E con S E by E all sail set washing ship & c, Middle part fine latter do washing Bone

Lat 30 44

Long 159 00

Monday 29th

29th Fine wind E to E S E all sail set washing S E by S to doing Bone Middle squally bad weather latter part strong gales at E heading S by E all sail set, washing & doing Bone

Lat 28 05 Long 155 40
