light, Middle post fine latter Strong gales
at S, heavy swell from the S W Lat 19 45

Monday 25th Long 153, 33

25th Strong gales at S heading S W by S Main
by Sails set, heavy swell, Middle post
Most latter do fine working latter 15
Lat 20, 10

Tuesday 26th

26th Most, wind S heading to the S Windward
all sail set & point of English bearing S W
Spoke Clipper Ship, Onward of S W Redford
Middle post fine, latter do Lat 20 29

Wednesday 27th Long 154, 54

27th Most wind light from the S working latter
wind light, Bent fore top sail to, Middle
post the same latter fine light wind

Thursday 28th Lat 20, 46

28th Most wind S heading to the S all sail
at 6 backed to the E Middle post Most latter
do heading S W by S wind S

Friday 29th

29th Fine wind S E heading to the S all
sail set 1 sail in sight, came up, & passed
us
