8th Calm with occasionally a light air from the E, & days of here, with the good dories. Nearest wind, that ever Christ Blown light winds, from the N E & S E & Middle at daylight Daring, Latter part Daring with N E & S E

Monday 9th

9th Most wind N con N E all sail set at 6 cleared of fine Middle part fine - Latter do calm Lat 45 32

Tuesday 10th Long 145 02

10th Fine calm & light air from the S W con N E Middle part calm at daylight a breeze from the S W con N E

Wednesday 11th

11th Most wind S W con N E all sail set, cloudy, overcast, Middle part most Latter do at 10 A breeze from the N W all sail set, a sail in sight breaking out water Lat 43 44.

Thursday 12th Long 152 00

12th Most wind N W con N E all sail set a sail in sight filled water Butt got 2 popsis wind N Middle part strong gales Latter do at 10 wind N to S W all sail

Friday 13th Lat 43 08 Long 154 32

13th Fine light air from the S W con N E all sail set. Calm at 4 light from the N Middle part fine Latter do strong gales Lat 42 05

Saturday 14th Long 157 12

14th Fine with strong gales at S W con N E all sail set. Flying sick must my wife & Baby gal. Middle part fine wind N Latter part do dark cloudy.

1860, Boat Isabella towards B Deland

Sunday 15th Jan 1860

15th Strong gales from the N heading E N E at 3 took in ty sails & double reefed top sails. Daring & squally, rose, jib, all to pieces posted for shut & with much thunder & lightning. Middle part more most at 12 wind N set double reefs. Latter part most Bent new jib. Lat obs 40 28

Monday 16th Lat 40 16 Long 162 40

16th Heavy gales at N con N E took in ty sails double reefed top sails, handed jib, Middle part fine wind S W Latter do all sail set cutting up jib Lat obs 38 51

Tuesday 17th Lat 38 25 Long 163 11

17th Fine wind S W con N E all sail set Middle part fine. Latter do very pleasant fine Lat obs 37 14

Wednesday 18th Lat 37 04 Long 163 12

18th Fine wind S W con N E all sail set fitting rigging &c. Took pair flap shoes on old whale ground where I have cruised before con N E. Middle part fine, Latter the same overhauled flap lark, killing moths Lat obs 36 06

Thursday 19th Lat 35 34 Long 163 42

19th Fine wind E N E heading N all sail set at 4 hove aboard & spoke the Pash lantern jacket of 16 B 31 mus 12 con Spm Capt come on board, Middle part most Latter do standing to the E light air & calm Lat obs 35 36

Friday 20th Lat 35 35 Long 163 44

20th Most wind N W E heading E all sail set saw nothing. Middle part Daring & squally took in sail, at 12 wind S W cloud of smoke, Latter part fine breaking out to find paper shovels. Depurging old oil casks.
