Stood of shore cutting up Blubber

Wednesday 29th

29th Nov. Mond. S.E. heading of S.W. Lane I sail at 6
and to Middle post the Lane to the fog & rain at
7 started fires & commenced boiling.

30th. Most usual 90 heading, 1070 by 10 main by sail
set. Boiling at 9 sun & light whale lowered & chest
middle part fog latter do working 80
cooled down. Thudding 81st
