end to them, Middle part thick fog latter do rain &
fog Friday 15th

15th. Most wind S E con S by E all sail set thick
fog, & rain took in by back & fly jib fore & main
sail thick at 8 sail the sand, ^{disappeared of having my nose} ^{Billings} to the S E
Middle part clear, ^{by my eye} latter part quite
fine wind S W, heading to the W fog at intervals
sweet wife sent home Saturday 16th

16th. Most wind S E heading S W all sail set
sail 20 to 25 miles dist. fog make find that my
mate eats all kinds of food when I am not by
Middle part rain & fog latter rain at intervals calm
Sunday 17th Lat 59.34 Long 143.05

17th. Most all sorts of weather clear foggy sailing to
at 1 San the land hauled to inshore at 6 rose to the
S off shore at 10 Misery on Middle part calm latter
part light air & calm, sweet wife how I should like your
company Monday 18th Lat 59.45 Long 142.02

18th. Calms & light air from the S W con E S E all sail
set along shore Middle part fine latter do. Departed
fly jib &c Tuesday 19th Lat 59.37 Long 141.55
19th. Fine clear & pleasant wind S E & E at 5. ^{disappeared of seeing my old} ^{thats a good} ^{grace} ^{Billings} ^{San} ^{to the} ^{S E} ^{sweet wife & home} ^{Middle part calm} ^{at 4 light air} ^{from the W con S E} ^{strong gales & clear} ^{Mount St Elias}
at 11 Cape Bar weather in sight Lat 59.15
