Lat 5935 Long 14734 Wednesday 15th July 1860
18th Fine light airs from SE con SW by S
all sail set calm broke out weather
Latter part calm Lat 5930

Thursday 19th Long 14824
19th Fine calm calm, oh Lord my Creator
preserver, & Redeemer, thy hand lies
heavy upon me, oh Lord, have mercy upon
me Middle part calm latter do light airs
from the E Friday 20th Lat 5915 Long 14850

20th Fine calm at 4 anchored for humpbacks
struck killed at 1 got along side & turned
in at 3 hooked on, at 10 got through calm
Saturday 21st

21st Fine wind S E light airs & calms
cutting up blubber to middle part calm at 4
squared for humpbacks ^{discussed of having a gill in} fog at 9 cleared of
lowered & shot chased

Sunday 22nd Lat 5915 Long 14900
Breeze 22nd Fine light airs at E con SW all sail
set, commenced Bailing cooled down
calm latter do

Monday 23rd
23rd Fine wind calm at 1 light airs from the S E
all sail set Bailing, wind con SW Middle part
calms & light airs latter part light airs

Tuesday 24th Lat 5856 Long 14910
24th Light airs from the S heading to the N
all sail set Bailing at 2 lowered for hump
backs Middle part thick fog cooled down
latter part the same, at 7 o'clock William Roberts
died 4 mos sickness East Cambridge
Mass

Wednesday 25th
25th Light airs from the E con S E cleared of
sun the land fog again at 6 Buried W Roberts
Middle part fog at 8 cleared from a ship which
spoke the Jefferson of Say Harbor Capt came
on board

Thursday 25th July 1860
1860 25th Most thick fog & dead calm yawning
Middle part calm fog latter do Morning down
steaming to 180 all sail. My god has ever been kind
& good to me, praise, Friday 26th Lat 5820
26th Most light winds from the S E Capt Huntington
came on board. Middle part fog at 9 went on board
praise god & give thanks for his good latter part thick
fog. Saw plenty of humpbacks

Saturday 27th Lat 5821
27th Most wind light from the S E thick fog
at 3 blowed of lowered & struck killed took
along side at 8, the good Lord be praised
top M in sail at 3 hooked on at 6 got him in
latter part fine cutting up blubber
the Lord have mercy Sunday 28th Lat 5824

28th Most wind S E lowered, struck on broke
at 3 got on board at 6 lowered one boat struck
dressed hoisted up Middle part fog at 9
lowered 1 Boat struck running to the windward

Monday 29th Lat 5825 Long 15107
29th Fine wind S E Boats down fast to a whale
at 4 line got around a loose whale & fastest
come on board. Middle part fine latter do

Tuesday 30th Lat 5825
30th Fine wind & heading to the S all sail set at 2
lowered for humpbacks No luck saw the Jefferson
take one, cooled down to 60 M Middle part strong gales
double Decks discussed of seeing Sarah on ship
of being at home at my own door latter part strong
gales fore & main top sails thick & rainy very
dugged

Wednesday 31st
31st Hard gale at 8 more to the S set fore sail &
at 3 fell calm rose to the S E made sail
Middle part most the Mercies of an overruling Being
at daylight commenced breaking out to storm
spoke the Ocean Capt Clark came on board
dugged lowered & chased No go Lat 5808
