4th Boats of chasing saw a large number

Saturday 5th

5th Boats out after whales using up time & patience

Sunday 6th

6th Boats out chasing no luck, sold & put on board

Monday 7th 9000 galls oil took

7th The same, got a whale at 9 got alongside
in the morning cut him in

Tuesday 8th

8th Boats out, cutting up blubber at daylight lighted
latter part boiling

Wednesday 9th

9th Boats out chasing boiling

Tuesday 3rd March 1861

4th Fine weather 3 Boats out whaling 1 on board setting
up rigging repairing old larks to sailed ship
California for the Islands by Acacia 115.20
