

Bark Kabella in the Arctic Ocean 1861

Thursday 9th Aug 1861

9th Fine wind S heading to the S W all sail set Boiling repairing Casks to Middle & Latter part fine Boat into the ke Realsing

Wearied of losing all Friday 10th my front teeth

10th Fine wind S E on different tacks Boiling at dusk got on board with 15 walrus hoisted them in Middle & Latter part fine standing to the S Lat 67 42

Saturday 11th Aug 170 15

11th Most wind E heading to the S Boiling see 10 ships 1 Ketting, cutting up walrus Middle part fine Latter part strong gales standing to the S

Sunday 12th

12th Strong gales from the S E heading S W top sails spoke Bury & here, at 4 cooled down 120 Bls rose to the S E double deep Middle part strong gales Latter foggy & Rainy starting water to stow oil

Monday 13th

13th Most wind S E heading to the N short sail strong down oil, spoke Bark Phillip St. capt came on board Middle part calm Latter part calm & light air from the N W steering of & clearing up

Tuesday 14th

14th Most wind N W lying aback foggy, boiled out walrus spoke the Here Middle part most Latter part foggy & Rainy washed ship &

Wednesday 15th

15th Most wind E standing to the N & E 15 E foggy Middle part most Latter part strong gales steering away Bone spoke Bury Kohola Horn Capt came on board stood to the S

Thursday 16th

16th Strong gales from the N stood to the S Sun of W lapped to the S 6 ships in sight Middle part strong gales from the W Latter do kept of E N E Drum by 2nd

Friday 17th Aug 1861

17th Strong gales W on S E & Main by set, passed the Cosinarian ready get at dusk luffed to strong gales double deep top sails Latter more most middle sail set by sail passed point Hope

Saturday 18th

17th Most wind W standing to the S at 4 see whales lowered & chased, Middle part the same Latter do heading to the S at 11 kept of for Lisburne see a whale once

Sunday 18th

18th Fine wind S W steering S E, passed Cape Lisburne see 6 ships, spoke the James Lane of Bedford Capt came on board likewise Capt Turner of the Brazanga, Middle part fine Latter do boats on shore getting wood

Monday 19th

19th Most wind S lying along shore wooding at came on board 6 Boat loads made sail to the S Middle part strong gales double deep top sails Latter do Lat 69 10

Tuesday 20th Aug 167 37

20th Strong gales at S heading to S W double deep at 4 set by sails & fly jib at 11 wind S kept S W Latter part fine wind S on S all sail set 3 or 4 ships

Wednesday 21st Lat 68 34 Aug 171

21st Strong gales at S W on S spoke the Reindeer got a man that deserted at Honolulu at 11 luffed to the S W spoke the Bale cutting Middle part strong gales Latter part fine see whales lowered & chased, at 11 lowered again Lat 68 29

Thursday 22nd

22nd Fine wind N Boats down cruising at 5 struck killed look alongside at 7 commenced cutting at 1 got through turned in at 6 cleared decks, Druggal

Friday 23rd 68 21

23rd Strong gales Wind S W Boiling Middle part fine Latter do see a whale thousands of walrus standing on different tacks
