stern & several whales did not lower
went on shore for potatoes &c
Middle part strong gales. Latter part
do watch on shore

Sunday 9th

9th Strong gales. Watch on shore. got on
board. Kirtly no better. Middle part most
arrived ship. Bane & Bouland. Latter part
most. Thosida got a whale painting
ship

Monday 10th

10th Fine wind 6 & painting ship &
fair. Middle part a gale. Latter do Jonesell
for a whale painting ship

Tuesday 11th

11th A H gale. Boats got a barrel. went
on shore for potatoes &c a gale
Middle part a gale. Latter part more most
fitting men by back steps

Wednesday 12th

12th Strong gales fitting back steps. required ship
Othello KB middle part a gale. Latter do

13th Fine fitting ship & Middle part strong gales

Friday 14th

14th Most doing odd jobs. Middle part fine
Latter do chased whales

Saturday 15th

Sunday 16th

16th Most Boats of at 2 got on Barrel
Bary got a whale. Thosida cutting Middle
part & dugged. Latter do of whaling

Monday 17th

17th Strong gales. Middle part very dugged
Latter more most Boats of chasing

Tuesday 18th

18th quite fine Boats of chasing

Left Saypan 12th March, for Guam to get
water

Left Guam the 18th March for Japan

Anchored at Ojokohama 12th May April

Left on the 21st for Kure Ocean

Took on board 90 barrels of potatoes 2 do of rice
2 do of Beans

Long 178.20 East
Lat 61.37

Thursday 20th May 1862

20th Fine light winds from the 6 & spoke the Bary
capt came on board. Middle part fine at 2 miles
the K. Lapes Savasin & Thosida in sight 25
miles to W. saw the Bask Tanny sailing into
through scattering ice

Lat 62.00 East

Friday 21st

21st Fine light winds from the 1 heading to the 6
along the K. Tanny & Bary in sight. Middle part
Most. Latter part fine burning through the ice
saw a Musch digger Bary Thosida & Tanny in sight
Lat 62.55
