

*Re Behnings & Sails*

*Sunday 5th July 1862*

5th Mott wind N E foggy & rainy. 3 ships in company at 7 backed to the N Middle past Mott thick fog at 8 see the land latter part thicker

*Monday 7th*

7th Mott wind E rose to the N thick fog by the land once, at 11 set go anchor 12 fathoms latter part cleared of see the land

*Tuesday 8th*

8th Mott lying at anchor 6 miles off shore wind E sea calm east, Middle past strong gales N E latter part more Mott Bore thick fog & rain

*Wednesday 9th*

9th Mott wind N E thick fog & rain. Lying at anchor Barometer 29.40th. Home & friends. Reading My wife's letters Middle past thick fog smell from the E Bar. 29.00 latter part the same heavy smell from the E

*Thursday 10th*

10th Mott gales at 10 E heavy smell at 8. Reefed got ready to weigh anchor. Bar. rising slowly Middle past Mott cleared off of the mouth of at 5 took anchor & steamed to the N fine & pleasant

*Friday 11th*

11th Fine light airs from the S E cou. N E all sail set steering for Cape East at 6 lost sight of the land. at thick fog at 11 anchor thick fog & rain at 7 cleared of a little see the Cape took anchor & made sail, foggy & rainy

*Saturday 12th*

12th Strong breezes from the N E working to the windward. spoke the Florida thick & rainy Middle past thick fog double reefed top sails latter part do strong gales

*Sunday 13th July 1862*

13th Strong gales at 6 N double reefed top sails thick fog & rain very drenched Middle past more Mott see the Cape latter do calm

*Monday 14th*

14th Mott wind N by Bland of see the Cape leaving N E made sail wind S E working up for the land. Middle past calm Bent main sail. latter part do light airs

*Tuesday 15th*

15th Fine light airs from the S all sail set working up for the Cape. strong gales at 5 AM came down at 7 sent a party on shore weathering at 11 AM got on board

*Wednesday 16th*

16th Fine light airs from S working up for the Cape at 10 spoke for Cape of Horse Middle past strong gales at 6 AM came to anchor at 8 sent a party on shore at 11 AM got on board

*Thursday 17th*

17th At anchor of Cape East at 1 sent a party on shore at 7 got on board got ready to weigh. Middle past calm at 5 took anchor & stood to the North latter part light airs from the South

*Friday 18th*

18th Light airs from the S cou N E calm Canoes com off Bot a lot of Boats Middle past fine latter do deposing in sail

*Saturday 19th*

19th Light winds from the S cou N E off North Cape deposed & Bent fore sail calm Middle past fine rain latter do heading N E rainy & foggy
