Thursday Aug 17

This day comes in with fine weather and
light Breezes middle and latter part Squally
saw finbacks the ship standing to the
South the sick men improving some
Lat by obs 6.02 Long by Chron 106.22

Friday Aug 18th

Comes in with fresh Breezes from S.E. the ship
standing to the Southward middle and latter part
Squally saw finbacks the sick men are about the same
Lat by obs 5.44 Long by Chron 105.55

Saturday Aug 19th

This day comes in with squally weather
and fresh Breezes from the S.E. the ship
on the Eastern tack saw nothing Mr. Lemonidine
is rather worse this day Davison is improving
some Doming is off Duty Sick Mammie
