a sail in Stering to the N.W.

Wednesday Nov 29th
These twenty four hours fresh Breezes and Chron
Weather at 4 P.M. Spoke the Constitution
off Nantucket at 2 P.M. parted Company
and stood to the N.W. Saw finbacks
Lat by obs ~~4.45~~ Long by Chron 101.45

Thursday Nov 30th
This day Comes in with fresh Breezes the Ship
Standing to the N.W. at 10 A.M. wore round
to the S.W. Saw a Ship Stering to the N.
at 4 P.M. Spoke the Harbouch of N.B.
Lat by obs 4.48 Long by Chron 102.45

Friday Nov. December 1st
These twenty four hours fresh trades and Squally
the Ship Standing to the S. at daylight Wore
round to the South a sail in light Standing to the
Eastward Lat by obs 5.02 Long by Chron 103.5

Saturday Dec 2nd
Comes in with fresh trade Winds the Ship Stand
to the Southward at Sunset tacked to the Eastward
and tacked again at Noon Saw Blackfish
and towed for them without Success. Cooper saw
Lat by obs 5.10 Long by Chron 102.32

Sunday Dec 3rd
These twenty four hours fresh trade Winds
the Ship Working to Westward Saw
Blackfish
Lat by obs 5.05 Long 102.3

Wednesday Dec 6th
This day Comes in with fresh trades the Ship on
the Eastern tack at 7 A.M. tacked to the Southward
a Ship in sight Standing to the Eastward
Saw finbacks bent a new till
Lat by obs 5.56 Long by Chron 102.05

Thursday Dec. 7th
These twenty four hours fine Weather and Moderate trade
Winds the Ship Standing to the Southward Saw
finbacks
Lat by obs 6.28 Long by Chron. 102.09

Friday Dec 8th
This day Comes in with light trades the Ship on
the Eastern tack a ship in sight Standing to
the Eastward Saw finbacks employed setting up
the fore Riggings.
Lat by obs 5.23 Long by Chron 101.25

Saturday Dec 9th
This day Comes in with light trades the Ship
Standing to the Southward Saw nothing
Lat by obs 5.33 Long 101.11
