any

Tuesday Dec 12<sup>th</sup>  
Comes in with light trades the ship working to the Eastward saw nothing ends with fresh trades.  
Lat by obs. 5.46 Long by Chron 100.04

Wednesday Dec 13<sup>th</sup>  
This day comes in with fine weather and moderate trades the ship on the Eastern tack at sunset took in the light sails at daylight Steered off North Employed setting up the Mainmast Back stays &c.  
Lat by obs 5.04 Long by Chron 99.56

Thursday Dec 14<sup>th</sup>  
This day comes in with fresh trades the ship steering off N. latter part steering S.W. Saw finbacks  
Lat by obs 5.14 Long by Chron 100.57

Friday Dec 15<sup>th</sup>  
This day comes in with fine weather and fresh trades the ship standing to S.W. at daylight Steered North  
Lat by obs 5.29 Long 101.22

Sunday Dec 17<sup>th</sup>  
Comes in with fine weather and light trades the ship steering off S.W. at sunset luffed to the Wind to the Southward at daylight Steered off North  
Saw nothing  
Lat by obs 4.45 Long by Chron 102.38

Monday Dec 18<sup>th</sup>  
These twenty four hours fine weather and moderate trade winds the ship steering off S.W. at sunset luffed to the Wind heading to the Eastward at daylight Steered South Charles Van Auder has got well again and gone to duty  
Lat by obs 4.49 Long by Chron 103.09

Tuesday Dec 19<sup>th</sup>  
Comes in with fine weather and moderate trade winds the ship on the Southern tack at sunset wore round to the Eastward saw finbacks at daylight tacked to the Southward  
Lat by obs 4.56 Long by Chron 103.32

Wednesday December 20<sup>th</sup>  
Comes in with fine weather and moderate trades the ship steering to the S.W. by the Wind latter part steering S.W. Saw nothing  
Lat by obs 4.55 Long by Chron 103.30

Thursday Dec 21<sup>st</sup>  
Comes in with fresh trades the ship standing to the S.W. a sail in sight on the starboard tack at sunset luffed to the Wind to the S.W. latter part standing to the Southward  
Lat by obs 4.58 Long 103.50
