

1856 Ship. Bolana of New Bedford Capt. Dorn
Sunday Feb 3rd

Comes in with fresh Breeze from the S. E. at 4 P.M. spoke the Ship Roscius of N.B. at 7 P.M. parted company latter part Moderate Standing to the S.W. at noon Massafusa bearing N.W. 12 miles

Monday Feb 4th

This day comes in with strong breeze from S. E. the ship standing to the Westward in company with the Ship Roscius latter part much the same spoke the Ship Richard Mitchell of Nantucket 50. Spm saw a Merchantman steering to the Eastward at noon the Island bearing N.E. 22 miles

Tuesday Feb 5th

Comes in with strong Breeze from the S.W. the ship steering N.W. at 4 P.M. shifted to the wind heading to the Eastward at sunset took in till & mainmast double reefed maintop sail & furled the Mizzen middle & latter part much the same saw several vessels bound in to the Eastward at noon Massafusa bearing E.N.E. 30 miles

Wednesday Feb 6th

Comes in with strong Breezes the ship steering to the Eastward by the wind a Ship in sight standing to the Westward saw finback at noon Massafusa bearing E.N.E. 15 miles

Thursday Feb 7th

Comes in with strong breeze from the Southward the ship standing to the Eastward middle part running round to leeward of the Island saw plenty of finbacks latter part fine weather at noon the Island of Massafusa bearing N.W. 30 miles

Friday Feb 8th

This day comes in with fresh Breezes from S.E. the ship standing to the S.W. & latter part much the same saw finback Carpenter off duty sick

Saturday Feb 9th

This day comes in with light breeze from the North the ship standing to the Westward middle & latter part strong breeze latter part steering S.W. saw nothing employed repairing the flying jib

This day comes in with fresh Breeze from the Northward the ship steering S.W. middle & latter part Moderate saw Blackfish two Barks in sight Carpenter sick
Lat 34.30 S

Monday Feb 11th

Comes in with gentle Breeze from the S.W. the ship steering to the S.E. at 5 P.M. spoke the Bark Virginia of N.B. middle part Calm latter part light Breeze from the Westward Carpenter well again and gone to duty
Lat 34.55 Long 82.44

Tuesday Feb 12th

Comes in with light Breezes from S.W. steering S.E. in company with Bark Virginia saw Grampass latter part standing to the North with Moderate breeze saw a Merchantman steering N.E.
Lat 34.45 Long 81.48 W.

Wednesday Feb 13th

Comes in with Moderate Breeze from the Westward the ship steering N.E. middle part much the same latter part steering to the N.E. at 9 A.M. saw Massafusa bearing N.E. 50 miles employed tarring rigging &c.

Thursday Feb 14th

Comes in with gentle Breeze from S.W. the ship steering to the N.W. middle & latter part Calm saw finback employed tarring rigging &c. at noon Massafusa bearing N.E. 16 miles
