Comes in with moderate breeze from S.W. the ship steering to the Northward Middle & latter part fresh Breezes at 7 A.M. the Island of St. Peter bearing W. by S. 40 miles.

Friday April 18th

Comes in with strong breeze from S.E. the ship steering by the Wind to the Eastward by the Wind, latter part squally at 8 A.M. saw Whales at 11 A.M. lowered three Boats the Starboard Boat struck about 1 P.M.

Saturday April 19th

This day comes in with strong Breezes from S.E. the ship laying back at 2 P.M. took the Whales alongside & commenced butting latter part fresh Breezes finished butting about 11 A.M.

Comes in with fine weather and light southerly winds the ship standing to the S.W. all hands employed boiling finished the head about day light.

Comes in with strong Breezes from the Southward the ship standing to the Eastward Middle & latter part laying to under double Reefed main top sail & foresail saw nothing

Friday April 25th

This day comes in with fine weather and light baffling winds the ship steering to the S.E. all hands employed showing down oil in the fore hold & fore funnels

Saturday April 26th

This day comes in with light breeze from S.E. the ship standing to the Eastward Middle & latter part nearly calm. Saw funnels

This day comes in with light trades and fine weather the ship standing to the Eastward Middle and latter part fresh trades saw funnels

Lat 22.42 Long 74.00 W

Monday April 28th

Comes in with fresh trades the ship steering to the Northward Middle and latter part much the same saw funnels. Employed setting up Shooks

This day comes in with light trades the ship steering North Middle and latter part moderate saw a school of Black fish. Employed setting up Shooks
