Miles. Middle part standing to the Eastward
saw finbacks. one man Sick. upright the
Gall sail to repair Lat 1.40 S Long 89.15 W

Ends with moderate trades. one man Sick

to the Southward Middle & latter part mist
and squally saw Everything but sperm Whales
John Edwards the Sick man remains about
same.
