

Ship. Baluena of New Bedford Capt Gorman
1856 Saturday Aug 16th

Comes in with fresh trades the ship on
standing to the Westward. Middle and latter part
Strong trades several vessels in sight Cruising off
Lee, Bay Saw finbacks, two men sick at noon the
Island of Nantuxough. Bearing E. by N. 20 miles

Sunday Aug 17th

Fresh trades the ship standing
to the Westward at 4 tacked in shore and spoke the
3 Barks Cape Horn Pison, & George & Susan of N.B. latter
part standing off shore saw finbacks at noon Nantuxough
bearing E. by N. 20 miles

Monday Aug 18th

This day comes in with fresh trades
the ship standing to the Westward middle and latter
part squally. saw several finbacks. and Sulphur bottom
employed repairing the mainsail. two men sick
Lat 0.43° Long 94.01 W

Tuesday Aug 19th

Comes in with fine weather and
fresh trades the ship steering N.W. by E. middle
and latter part much the same Employed repairing
the mainsail finished and bent it about noon.
two men sick. Lat 0.40° N Long 93.05 W

Wednesday Aug 20th

This day comes in with strong trades the ship
standing to the S.W. by the Wind saw the Barks And-
rews of N.B. latter part moderate trades saw porpoises
the sick men John Edwards, and Williams remain
about the same. Lat 1.04° N Long 93.03 W

Thursday Aug 21st

Comes in with moderate trades the ship
standing to the Eastward middle and latter
part moderate a Bark in sight to the West-
ward unbent the old foretop sail and bent another
old one. Lat 1.55° N Long 92.37 W

Ship. Baluena Cruising off the Culpepers
1856 Friday Aug 22^d

Comes in with fresh trades the ship standing to the
Eastward middle part standing S.W. at 10 tacked
to the Eastward saw one finback. employed repairing
the old foretop sail. two men sick. at noon Culpepers
Island bearing W.W. 20 miles

Saturday Aug 23^d

Comes in with fine weather and moderate trades
the ship working to windward with all sail set. saw
nothing finished repairing the foretop sail. a strong
current setting to the N.W.
Lat 1.56° N Long 92.00 W

Sunday Aug 24th

Comes in with fresh trades the ship
standing to the Eastward. saw porpoises
a strong N.W. current running
Lat 2.30° N

Monday Aug 25th

This day comes in with strong
trades the ship standing to the Eastward. saw
finbacks. three men sick
Lat 2.30° N Long 89.53 W
by Lunar 89.40 W

Tuesday Aug 26th

Comes in with fine weather and
strong trades the ship standing to the Eastward
saw finbacks. and Porpoises three men sick
Lat 1.43° N Long 88.14 W

Wednesday Aug 27th

This day comes in with strong
trades and squally weather the ship standing to
the Eastward middle and latter part much the
same saw porpoises the sick ones are about
the same. Lat 0.55° N Long 86.45 W
