Commenced with light Winds and fine Weather. Nothing of importance doing at 2 p.m. spoke Bark Java 17 Bants and 150 Barrels of Oil. Wind S.E. Current ... Abington bearing S.W. Dist 20 m.

Monday April the 20th

Commenced with light Winds and fair Weather. Employed doing nothing of importance in sight at 3 p.m. spoke Bark Java again and got 2 Barrels of Molasses and 6 bundles Iron Hoops and let them have 97 feet Pine Lumber. at 8 A.M. signalled a Bark supposed to be the Andrews of New Bedford. Abington bearing S.W. Dist 20 m. Wind S.E. Current W. slight. Lat. Long

Thursday April the 21st

Commenced with light Winds and fine Weather latter part squally with Rain. Nothing of consequence doing. Nothing of importance in sight. Wind S.E. Current W. 1/2 k. Abington bearing S.E. Dist 30 m. Lat. 40.52 N. Long 91.48 W.

Wednesday April the 22nd

Commenced with light Winds latter part strong Breezes. Nothing of importance doing. Nothing in sight. Wind S.E. Current W. 1/2 k. North Head in sight bearing S. Dist 40 m. Lat. 40.55 N. Long 91.48 W.

Thursday April the 23rd

Commenced with light Breezes and fair Weather. Employed making spinnage. Nothing of importance in sight. Latter part saw two Sails steering to the Eastward. Wind S.E. Current W. 1/2 k. Wenmans Island bearing N. Dist 40 m. Lat. 40.51 N. Long 92.13 W.

Friday April the 24th

Commenced with light Winds and fair Weather. Latter part had some rain. Employed making spinnage. Nothing of importance in sight. Wind E.S.E. Current W. 2 k. Wenmans Island bearing N. Dist 30 m. Lat. 40.48 N. Long 92.30 W.

Saturday April the 25th

Commenced with light Winds latter part strong Breezes. Weather fair. Employed making new Barrow spirit shrouds. saw a Bark. but no Whales. Wind E.S.E. Current W. 1 k. Wenmans Island bearing E.S.E. Dist 30 m. Lat. 1.15 N. Long 92.11 W.

Sunday April the 26th

Commenced with light Winds and fair Weather. Nothing doing. two Barks in sight. Wind E.S.E. Current W. 1.2 k. Culp bearing E.S.E. Dist 20 m. Lat. 1.39 N. Long 92.14 W.

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Monday April the 27th

Commenced with strong Breezes and fair Weather. at 2 p.m. lowered for Whales. Boat struck and killed a small Whale got him to the Ship at Sundown latter part employed cutting Bark. Cathapa in sight Culp bearing E.S.E. Dist 13 m.



Thursday April the 28th

Commenced with light Winds and fair Weather. Employed cutting up Bluebox and getting back for Oil latter part commenced hauling. Nothing of importance in sight. Wind S.E. Current W. 1/2 k. Lat. 1.58 N. Wednesday April the 29th

Commenced with light Winds and fine Weather. Employed hauling finished at 4 P.M. Nothing of importance in sight. saw two Barks. Wind S. Current W. 1 1/2 k. Culp in sight bearing S. E by E. Dist 35 m. Lat. 2.05 N. Long 92.37 W.

Thursday April the 30th

Commenced with light Winds and fair Weather. Employed Steering up Decks and so forth. at Sundown spoke Barks of Atlantic and Ben. Cummings. at 8 A.M. got 4 Bundles Iron Hoops from the Ben Cummings and let her have a Blubber Hook. Wind variable. Current W. 1 1/2 k. Culp bearing S. E by E. Dist 35 m. Lat. 2.02 N. Long 92.36 W.

Friday May the 1st

Commenced with light Breezes and fine Weather. Employed putting out new Barrow spirit shrouds and cooping Oil. three Barks in sight. Wind S. Current W. 1 1/2 k. Ship steering by the Wind Eastward. Lat. 1.55 N. Long 92.38 W.

Saturday May the 2nd

Commenced with light Winds and pleasant Weather. Employed stowing down Oil. stowed 32 Barrels. two Barks in sight. Nothing of importance in sight. Wind S. Current more to the S. of E. Culp bearing E.S.E. Dist 20 m. The Ship is by the Wind to the Eastward. Lat. 1.48 N. Long 92.30 W.

Sunday May the 3rd

Commenced with light Winds and pleasant Weather. Nothing doing. Nothing of importance in sight. saw 3 Barks. Wind S. Current S.W. 1/2 k. Wenmans Island bearing S. Dist 12 m. Lat. 1.29 N. Long 92.22 W.

Monday May the 4th
