 This day Breeze with clear & pleasant weather very light wind from North Steering N.W. under all Sails middle part wind from E Steering the N.W. Latter part thick fog Steering the same

Sunday June 14th
 This day Breeze with strong wind from Eastward Steering N.W. under all Sails Thick fog at 2 o'clock P.M. took in light Sails at 7 o'clock took in courses and upper Topsails Luffed to the wind on Starboard tack middle part the same Latter part moderate wind Thick fog

Monday June 15th
 This day Breeze with light wind from South heading E by S under Lower Topsails Thick fog and rainy middle part clear up light wind from S.E. Latter part nice weather fresh wind heading N.E. under all Sails

Tuesday June 16th
 This day Breeze with cloudy weather fresh wind from S.E. heading N.E. at 7 o'clock P.M. Shorten Sails Saw finback middle part fog at 3 o'clock in morning raised whale on Sea water goin to the windward Thought was N. whale get Boat ready came on Thick fog did not see them again at 9.30 A.M. raised a lon sperm whale goin to the windward came on rain & Thick fog lost sight of him again
 Breaking out beam & rice

Wednesday Bark Petrel June 17th 1891

This day Breeze with rain & Thick fog very light Wind from S.E. heading South at 7 o'clock took in Sails Breaking out water middle part calm Latter part clear up light breeze from S.E. heading S by W Set all the light Sails Saw finback Spout

Thursday June 18th

This day Breeze with fog weather light wind from S.E. heading S by W at 7 P.M. took in light Sails middle part Thick fog light wind from S.W. heading N by N Latter part clear fresh breeze under all Sails Employed in Ship's duty

Friday June 19th

This day Breeze with fog and rain weather strong wind from S.E. heading S by W at 7 o'clock took in all Sails but main Lower Topsail & Fore Topsail Set Fore Stay sail middle part moderate wind Set fore Top sail Latter part heavy squalls from South Set Fore sail & main Topsail Steering S.E.

Saturday June 20th

This day Breeze with Gale wind from S.W. & rain squalls took in all the Sails but main Lower Topsail & Fore Stay sail Lay to on Starboard tack middle part blowing hard from Westward & rain squalls Latter part the same under Lower main Topsails & Fore Stay sail
