 P.M. took in light Sails & Topsails.
 middle part very light breeze from W Steering
 S.W. Latter part the same under all Sails
 Cloudy weather Employed in Ship's duty

Monday July 6th

This day Begone with cloudy weather
 fresh wind from W heading S.W. by S at
 7 o'clock P.M. Shorten Sails
 middle part Squally Latter part Strong
 wind under Lower Topsails Cloudy weather
 at 4th P.M. were Ship heading N.E.

Tuesday July 7th

This day Begone with cloudy weather & light
 fog Strong breeze from W Steering North
 at 7 o'clock P.M. Shorten Sails Breakout Coffee
 & Rice gr. 2 Salons of vinegar in Steerage &
 2 3/4 in forecabin middle part haliback
 main yard Latter part Steering N.E. under
 Topsails foggy weather Employed Ship's duty
 Breakout Barrel Same

Wednesday July 8th

This day Begone with foggy weather fresh
 Wind from W.S.W. Steering E.S.E. at 7 o'clock
 Shorten Sails Snuffed to the wind on Starboard
 Pack middle part hole back main yard
 Latter part Steering S.E. under Lower Topsails
 Thick fog & Strong breeze

Thursday July 9th 1891

This day Begone with foggy weather Strong wind
 from W.S.W. under Lower Topsails & fore sail at 7 o'clock
 took in fore Sails Snuffed to the wind on Starboard
 Pack heading S. middle part raining wind from
 W heading E.S.E. Latter part were Ship to the westward
 heading W under Lower Topsails foggy weather

Friday July 10th

this day Begone with foggy weather and light
 Winds from S.W. heading S.W. & heavy swell
 middle part Strong wind from W heading N.S.W.
 Latter part the same took in Lower fore Topsails
 rainy weather Employed in break out water
 Saw a fin back & porpoise

Saturday July 11th

this day Begone with Strong wind from W
 at 4 P.M. were Ship heading N.E. Set fore Topsails
 middle part heading N.E. Latter part the same
 Set upper Topsails clear weather and pleasant
 Lat 60° 50 North
 Long 30° 35 West

Sunday July 12th

this day Begone with rainy weather wind from
 W heading N.W. took in upper Topsails & fore sail
 middle part blowing quite hard Latter part
 moderate gale & clear weather Saw School
 of porpoise Lat 60° 05 North
 Long 30° 50 West

Monday July 13th

this day Begone with very light breeze from
 W heading N.W. under Lower Topsails cloudy
 weather middle part wind from S.W. Steering W.W. rainy
 weather at 9 o'clock A.M. saw a whale turn P. back
 on Starboard bow Cruising for him did not see him
 again and sail in sight to the leeward
 Lat 60° 26
 Long 32° 50
